



The Gambia revised ICT4D Plan

The NICI process in the Gambia followed the methodology developed by ECA under the AISI framework, which stipulates that the NICI process in a given country should be conducted in phases with each phase yielding specified and related deliverables. In this context, the NICI plan was revised in 2010 to reorganize the 10 policy focus areas into 10 pillars taking into account the recommendations of the World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS).

The Gambian 'WSIS-compliant' ICT4D-2013 Plan is designed to implement the provisions of the country's NICI Policy. Each pillar is designed to incorporate specific programmes and initiatives for implementing in concrete terms the various actions of the WSIS Plan of Action. Development of The Gambian ICT4D-2013 Action Plan is being undertaken in two sub-phases. The first phase, which is completed, focused on the development of the sub-plans for "Human Resource Development, ICTs-in-Education, and ICT-in-Communities". It will be followed by a second phase dealing with remaining pillars.
