## INTRODUCTION

1. Reference is made to the Dakar/Ngor Declaration on Population, Family and Sustainable Development (DND, Dakar, 1992), the Programme of Action of the International Conference on Population and Development (ICPD Cairo, 1994) and the Key Actions for the further implementation of the Programme of Action of the International Conference on Population and Development (ICPD+5 *Key Actions*, New York, 1999)<sup>1</sup>. The DND, the ICPD-PA and the ICPD+5 *Key Actions* recommended, among others, a set of policies and strategies that should be implemented by member states and the UN family in order to reduce population growth, eradicate poverty, protect the environment and hence, promote sustainable development. In adopting the Declaration, the Programme of Action and the ICPD+5 *Key Actions*, participating countries have committed themselves to monitor their implementation.

2. The year 2004 will mark the tenth anniversary of the ICPD and, as mandated by the General Assembly of the United Nations, the ECA will coordinate the preparation of Africa's input into the ten-year review and appraisal of ICPD i.e. ICPD+10. In order to update the work that was done in this area during the ICPD+5 process, a Regional evaluation report assessing progress and constraints in implementing the recommendations of the DND/ICPD and the ICPD+5 *Key Actions*, will be prepared as Africa's contribution to the Global report on ICPD+10.

3. As in 1998 for ICPD+5, the present questionnaire has been prepared to solicit information on the national experiences in the implementation of the DND/CPD and ICPD+5 *Key Actions* that will enable ECA to undertake a comprehensive ICPD+10 review, and draw relevant lessons therefrom. The ECA questionnaire complements the **UNFPA Field Enquiry Questionnaire** and also seeks information on important issues and concerns included in the DND. It will be appreciated if the questionnaire could be completed under the auspices of the most relevant body dealing with issues related to population and development, such as the national department responsible for the coordination of the implementation of population policies and programmes.

4. The findings of the analysis of the completed questionnaires will be summarized by ECA and included in the Regional evaluation report. The Regional evaluation report will be discussed at a Technical Meeting on selected themes (December 2003) and presented to the Fifth Meeting of the Follow-up Committee on the implementation of the DND/ICPD that will also act as a technical preparatory meeting for the ministerial-level meeting (April 2004).
