



## **Swaziland NICI Policy**

The Swaziland NICI policy was adopted by Cabinet in August 2006 denoting the conscious realization by the leadership of the need for an ICT-led socio-economic development process with the potential of transforming the country into an information-rich, knowledge-based and technology driven economy and society. The NSDI process in Swaziland commenced in 2003 and the NICI policy included NSDI-related targets. The subsequent plan is being developed in an integrated approach to establish linkages and strong SDI/NICI coordinating mechanisms with the aim of promoting the increased access to and use of spatially based information resources in decision making processes and employing appropriate infrastructure and communication technologies leading to sustainable development.
