GST OUTCOMES ANALYSIS OF KEY CONCEPTS



- **Equity and Support Principles:** Reaffirms equity, CBDR-RC, implications for SD & poverty eradication and need for enhanced support
- Transition away from fossil fuels in Just, orderly & equitable –
 differentiated emissions reductions pathways, stranding assets \$1.4
 trillion in Africa by 2050 & SD, risk for fossil fuel export and producing
 countries in respect of foreign exchange earnings and fiscal space
- Tripling Renewable Energy and Low Emission Technologies early capital investment, energy access, integration in value chains, industrialization, critical minerals, trade rules-CBAM, jobs and livelihoods,
- Transition to climate resilient economies -International nature/GGA, funding gap, Temperature goal and their implication on the costs of adaptation and L&D, erosion of development gains.
- **Financing the transition:** quantum vis as needs, quantity of finance and technology access barriers
- International Cooperation Gaps: unfair international cooperation ecosystem that doesn't reflect continental needs or agency. Trade, finance, and technology system reforms are essential for equitable transitions.

METHODOLOGICAL FRAMEWORK FOR NDC PREPARATION



- **1. National context assessment**—development priorities, importance of adaptation and resilience , emissions profiles, base commitments
- 2. Evaluate policy space and trade offs socio-economic implications of transition pathways- differentiated energy transitions, co-benefits Jobs, food, energy access, local manufacturing, risks/just transitions principles,
- **3. Align with international cooperation** identify accessible international support/conditions, leverage regional initiatives, anchor regional strategies
- **4. Stakeholders' inputs** national, sub-national and local actors
- **5. Assess implementation readiness** institutional capacities, policy & regulatory frameworks implementation readiness roadmap
- **6. Monitoring & Transparency:** track distributional impacts and cobenefits through MRV systems.
