The Namibian Government through the Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism (MEFT) in collaboration with the Africa Union Commission (AUC), the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa (UNECA), the African Development Bank (AFDB) and the Pan-African Climate Justice Alliance (PACJA) will host the tenth Conference on Climate Change and Development in Africa, 24 to 28 October 2022, Windhoek, Namibia

The aim of the Conference is to create awareness and strengthen the capacity of the African Union Member States to access, manage, and deliver international and national climate finance.
