
The Namibian Government through the Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism (MEFT) in collaboration with the Africa Union Commission (AUC), the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa (UNECA), the African Development Bank (AFDB) and the Pan-African Climate Justice Alliance (PACJA) will host the tenth Conference on Climate Change and Development in Africa, 24 to 28 October 2022, Windhoek, Namibia

The aim of the Conference is to create awareness and strengthen the capacity of the African Union Member States to access, manage, and deliver international and national climate finance. Furthermore, it will provide a forum for discussion, networking and collaboration for participants to support member states to mobilize resources in order to effectively implement their Nationally Determined Contributions. The conference will bring together Government ministers from different African countries, climate change experts, policymakers, researchers and academics, as well as representatives of civil society, the private sector, and youth and women's groups will participate in the Conference.

In view of the above, the Government of the Republic of Namibia has waived all the VISA requirements to all delegates coming from countries that are not eligible for VISA upon arrival in Namibia. 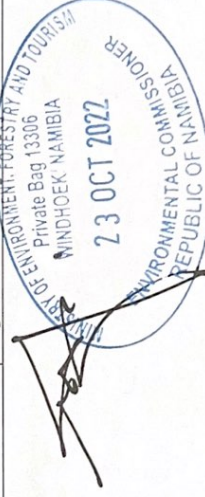
