Welcome to the meetings of the Statistical Commission for Africa, the Regional Committee of United Nations Global Geospatial Information Management for Africa and the Conference of African Ministers Responsible for Civil Registration, which will be held concurrently in Addis Ababa at the United Nations Conference Centre.

1. General information about Ethiopia

Ethiopia has an area of 1.1 million km², making it the tenth most populated country in Africa, and an estimated population of 120 million, the second largest in Africa. More than half the population is below 20 years of age. The capital, Addis Ababa, is situated 2,355 m above sea level.

Agriculture is the backbone of the national economy. The country's main agricultural exports include coffee, oil seeds, pulses, flowers, vegetables, sugar and animal feed. About 85 per cent of the population earn their living from the land. There is also a thriving livestock sector, and exports include cattle, hides and skins.

Ethiopia is a multi-ethnic State. Such is its linguistic diversity that 86 languages and 200 dialects are spoken. The four most widely spoken languages are Amharic, Oromo, Somali and Tigrinya. English, French, Italian and Arabic are also spoken, mainly in Addis Ababa.

2. Registration

In-person registration for the meetings of the Statistical Commission for Africa, the Regional Committee of United Nations Global Geospatial Information Management for Africa and the Conference of African Ministers Responsible for Civil Registration will open on 21 October 2022 at 8:30 a.m. You will be able to register and collect your badge and bag at the United Nations Conference Centre. Remember to bring your invitation and your passport. Once you have registered, you must wear your badge at all times at the meeting venue.

4. Dates and venue

The three meetings will be held concurrently in Addis Ababa from 24 to 28 October 2022, with a joint ministerial segment held at the headquarters of the African Union on 27 and 28 October. The expert segments of the meetings will be held at the United Nations Conference Centre from 24 to 26 October 2022, where a joint opening will be held. Several other pre-events will be held at the Conference Centre on 22 and 23 October 2022.

5. Entry requirements for Ethiopia, including coronavirus disease and other health-related information for Ethiopia

5.1 Visa

Participants from outside Ethiopia must have a visa. You will receive via email an MS Excel template, in which you are requested to provide the information that is required by the ECA Protocol Office for processing visa requests. Please complete the template and return it as soon as possible, along with a scanned copy of your passport data page, to Ayalnesh Asrat (asrat@un.org), Roman Legesse (legesser@un.org) and Meaza Bekele (bekele21@un.org), with copy to Gloria Mathenge (gloria.mathenge@un.org). Once the request has been approved by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, you will then need to apply for a visa through dedicated online portal of the **Immigration** and Citizenship (https://www.evisa.gov.et/).

5.2 Coronavirus disease requirements

- Anyone over the age of 12 entering Ethiopia at an international airport must possess a certificate of a negative PCR test taken no more than 72 hours before their departure or a negative rapid diagnostic test taken no more than 24 hours before their arrival in Ethiopia. The certificate is not valid for your return flight.
- Notwithstanding the above, you may enter the country without a PCR or rapid diagnostic test certificate if you have a coronavirus disease (COVID-19) recovery certificate issued no more than 90 days ago or you have evidence of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
- "Fully vaccinated" means that you took a single dose of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine or two doses of the AstraZeneca, Sinopharm, Sinovac, Moderna or Pfizer vaccine at least two weeks ago.
- Diplomats who do not meet the above two requirements may be tested at the airport. If they test positive for COVID-19 or refuse to be tested, they must selfisolate for seven days.
- Unless you are a diplomat, you may not enter the country if you test positive for COVID-19.
- During the meetings, the organizers may arrange COVID-19 rapid antigen tests if required for return flights or for onward international travel. Attendees are

advised to have valid health insurance, as they will be responsible for paying for any additional care required if they test positive.

- Each rapid antigen test will cost \$10 and each PRC test will cost \$25. The cost of each test will be paid by the participant. However, the Economic Commission for Africa will reimburse the cost of PCR and rapid antigen tests upon presentation of receipts.
- Those of you who are being sponsored by ECA, must present your boarding passes, COVID-19 test payment receipts and passports to receive payment of your daily subsistence allowance.
- Participants who test positive for COVID-19 will be quarantined at the Getfam Hotel and will be charged \$300 a day. You are therefore advised to have valid health insurance for your trip.
- If you require any other consultations or laboratory tests, they shall be at your own expense.

5.3 Other health requirements

- A valid yellow fever certificate is required to enter Ethiopia.
- If you take chronic medication, you are advised to bring an adequate supply of your medication, as some products may not be available in Addis Ababa.
- If you suffer from altitude sickness, you are advised not to attend the meeting in person.

5.4 More information

- Owing to security concerns, the Government of Ethiopia does not permit satellite phones or military reconnaissance equipment (such as binoculars, compasses, GPS devices or drones) to be brought into the country unless travellers show written permission from the Ministry of Innovation and Technology to import the equipment. Without such permission, Customs will seize the items at the airport.

6. Accommodation

A list of approved hotels in Addis Ababa is provided in the annex. You may contact the hotel directly by e-mail or telephone to make your own booking. If you need assistance with your hotel reservation, please contact us. All the major hotels in Addis Ababa are equipped with free Wi-Fi.

In addition to the cost of accommodation, you will be responsible for all other costs, such as room service, meals, telephone and fax bills, use of the mini-bar and laundry. You must pay the hotel for these services before your departure.

7. Airport transfer

Bole International Airport is located 5 km from the centre of Addis Ababa. Almost all hotels provide airport shuttle services. Please send your hotel and the Economic Commission for Africa (Meselu Seyoum, seyoum.uneca@un.org) your date of arrival, airline and flight number at least one week before your flight.

8. Transport

For travel in Addis Ababa, use either the metered yellow taxis or the blue taxis. Taxis are available 24 hours a day.

9. Additional information

9.1 Weather

Addis Ababa has a high-altitude Mediterranean climate, with average temperatures in late October ranging from a nighttime low of 10° C to a daytime high of 25° C. Rainfall occurs mainly during the cool season (three quarters of the annual total), which runs from June to September. Given the drop in temperatures after sunset, you may want to bring a light jacket or sweater just in case.

9.2 Electricity

Ethiopia uses socket types C and F. The mains supply is 220 V single phase.

9.3 Currency

The local currency is the Ethiopian birr ($\in 1 = 53.92$ birr, \$1 = 52.72 birr). Visa cards are accepted at most banks in Ethiopia. Ethiopian birr can be withdrawn from bank counters at the airport, in hotels, in banks, in the city or at ATMs.

The Commercial Bank of Ethiopia has a branch in the ECA compound, in the Congo building. The branch is open from Monday to Friday, from 8 a.m. to 12.45 p.m. and from 2 to 4.30 p.m.

Language

The official language of Ethiopia is Amharic. English is also widely spoken and, to a lesser extent, French and Arabic.

Local time

Universal Coordinated Time + 3 (UTC+3).

Telecommunications

The dialling code for Ethiopia is +251. SIM cards can be bought from Ethiopia Telecom offices in the city and at a kiosk at the airport. Both the SIM card and the mobile phone should be registered with Ethiopia Telecom before they are used.
