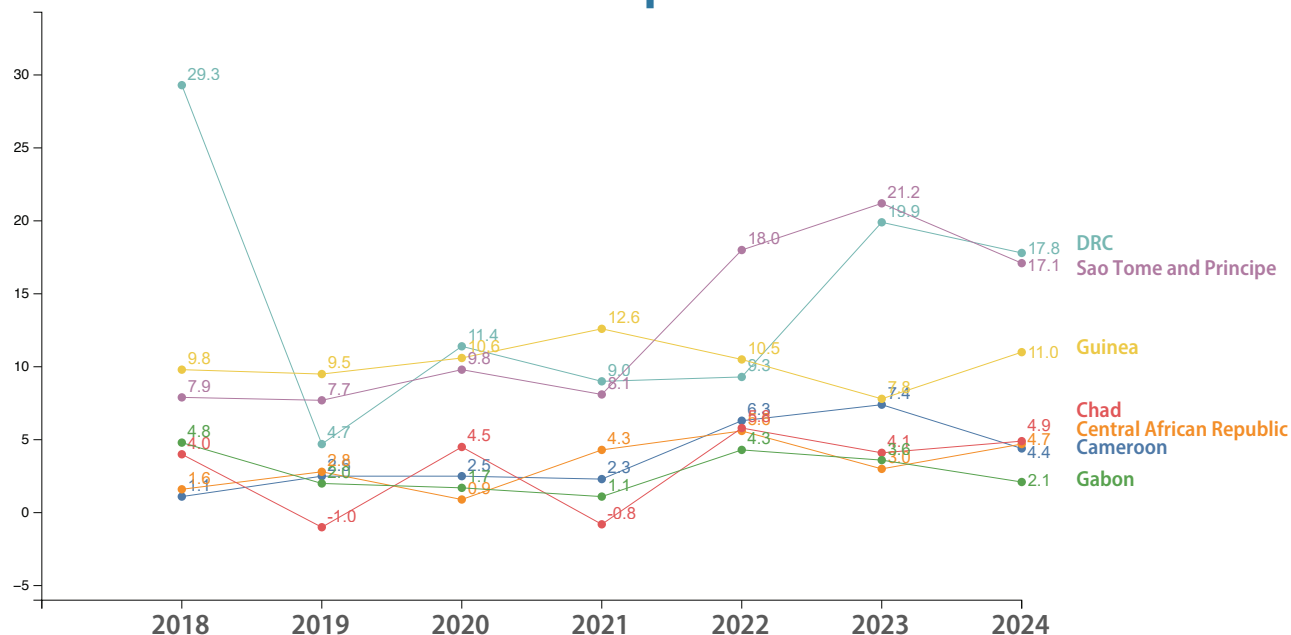
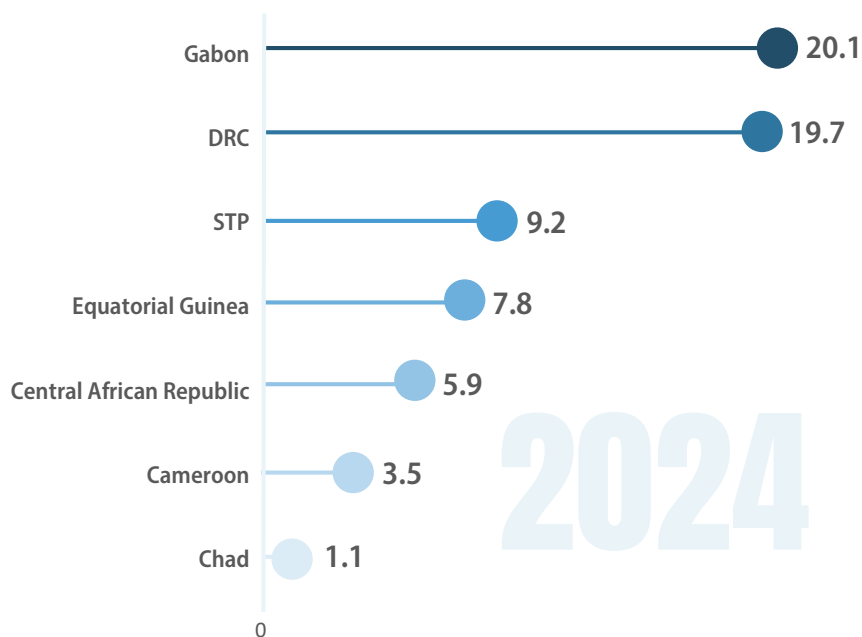

Gabon, a country with one of the highest GDP per capita rates in Central Africa, experienced sharp economic fluctuations post-2020, reflecting vulnerability due to dependence on oil. Despite an initially rapid post-pandemic recovery, growth has recently slowed, and inflation spiked to a high in 2022. The large industrial share of GDP masks the lack of manufacturing diversification, making the economy particularly susceptible to external commodity shocks. Coupled with persistently high external debt, these indicators suggest significant policy and structural challenges ahead for economic stability.

Central Africa: A Comparative View of Inflation

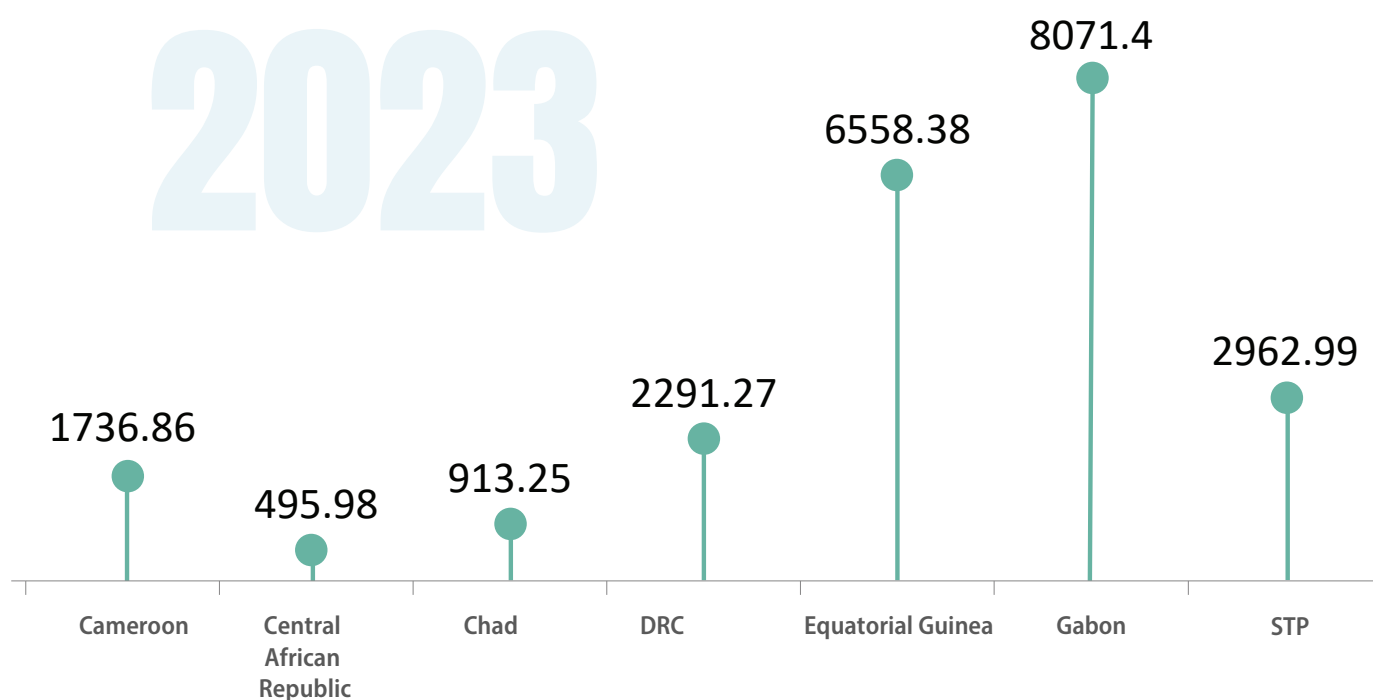
Unemployment Rates
In Central African Countries

In 2024, unemployment rates across seven Central African countries show a wide gap. Chad reports the lowest rate at just 1.1%, while Gabon faces a much higher rate of 20.1%. On average, the region's unemployment sits around 9.6%, but that figure hides some big differences between countries. This spread, shows just how varied the labor market conditions are in the region, and the differences likely reflect each country's unique context, including how diversified their economies are, the availability of resources, demographic pressures, and national employment policies.

CENTRAL AFRICA

In 2023, Gabon and Equatorial Guinea remained the wealthiest countries in Central Africa, with GDP per capita at around \$8,071 and \$6,558, respectively. At the other end, the Central African Republic continued to face economic challenges, with a GDP per capita of just about \$496, making it the poorest in the region. Economic growth varied significantly across the region. Chad led the group with an impressive 4.9% real GDP growth, followed by Cameroon at 3.2% and Gabon at 2.4%. However, Equatorial Guinea experienced a notable economic decline, with a real GDP contraction of -5.7%, and also recorded the sharpest decrease in GDP per capita at nearly -7.9%. São Tomé and Príncipe and the Republic of the Congo showed minimal growth, indicating stagnant economic conditions. Most countries in the region shared a stable currency exchange rate (CFA Franc) of around 585.91 per US dollar, except São Tomé and Príncipe, which maintained a significantly different exchange rate of 21.88 per US dollar. Overall, the economic situation across Central Africa in 2023 highlighted substantial inequalities, with some countries experiencing steady growth while others faced persistent economic downturns.

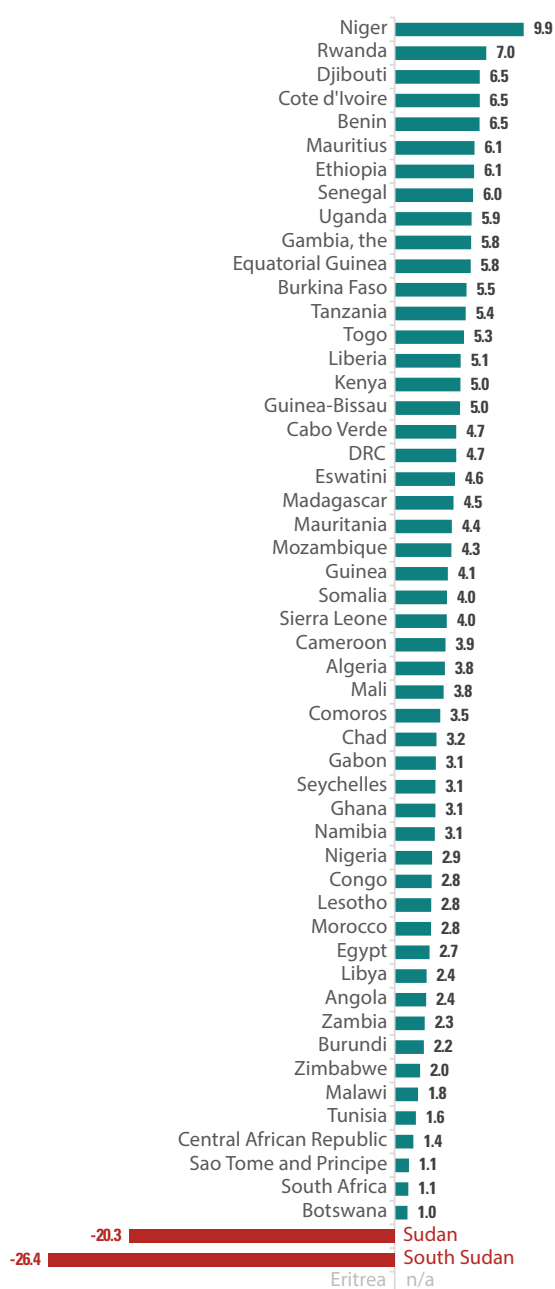
GDP per Capita (USD)



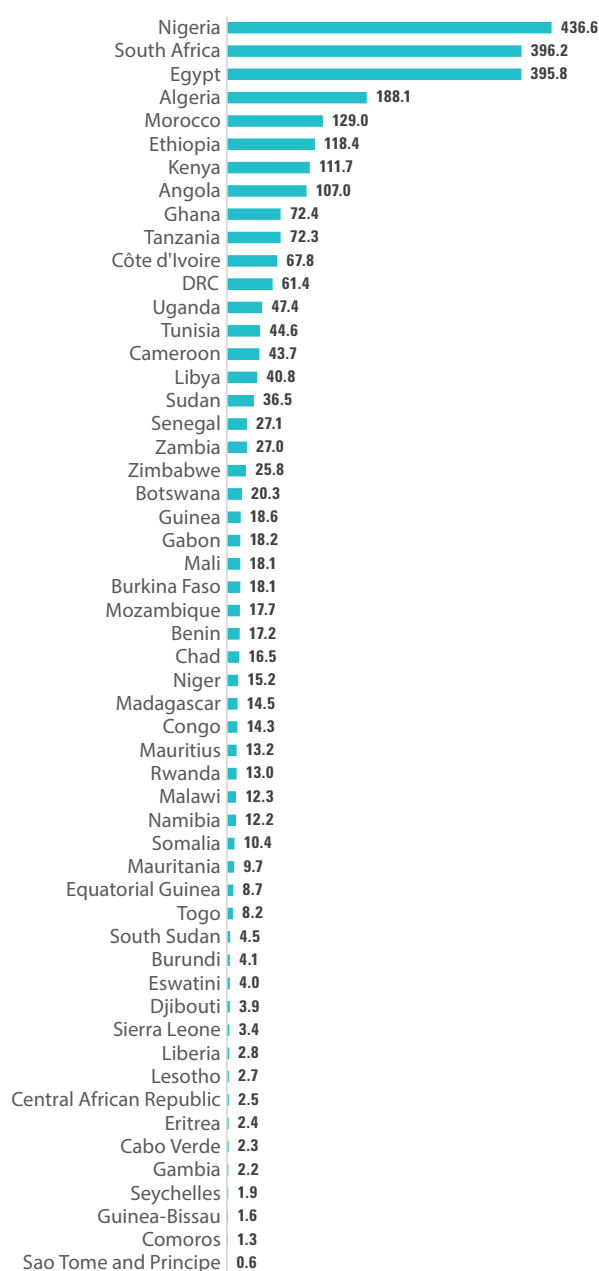

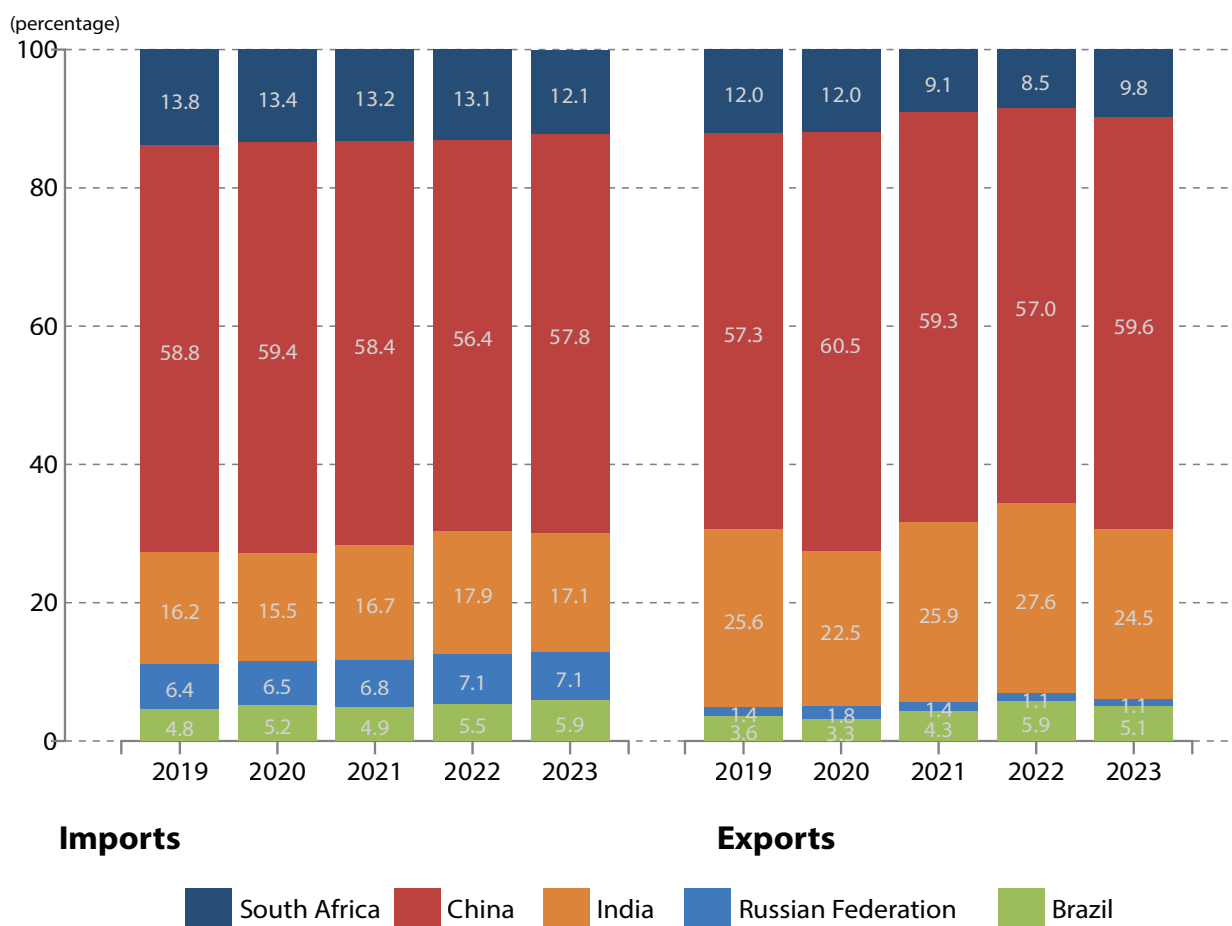

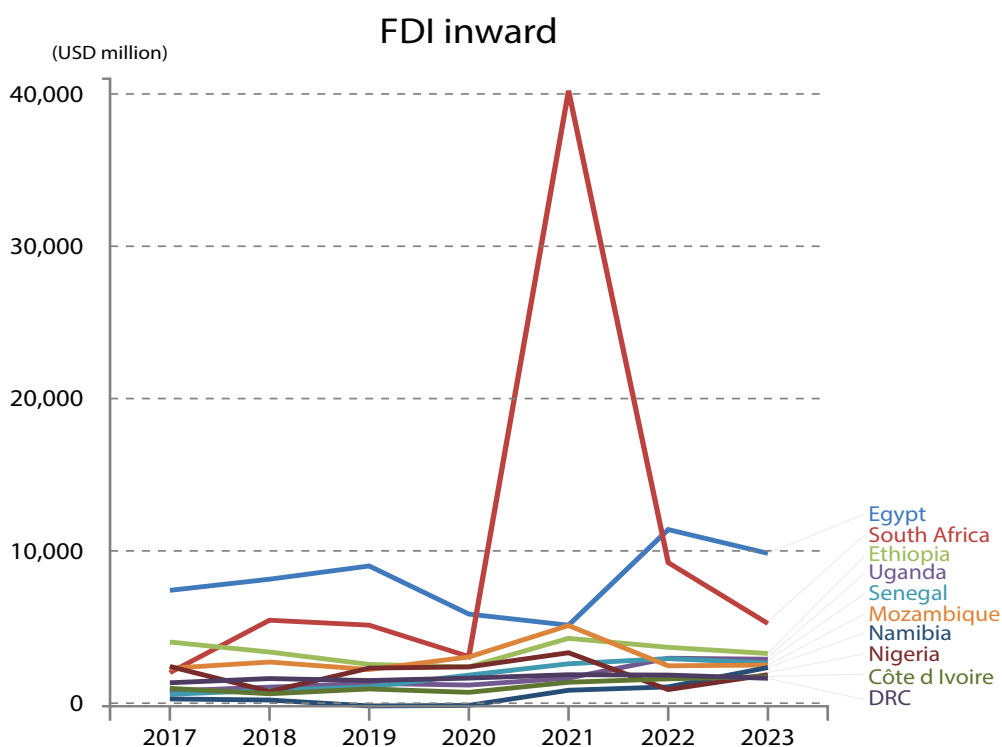

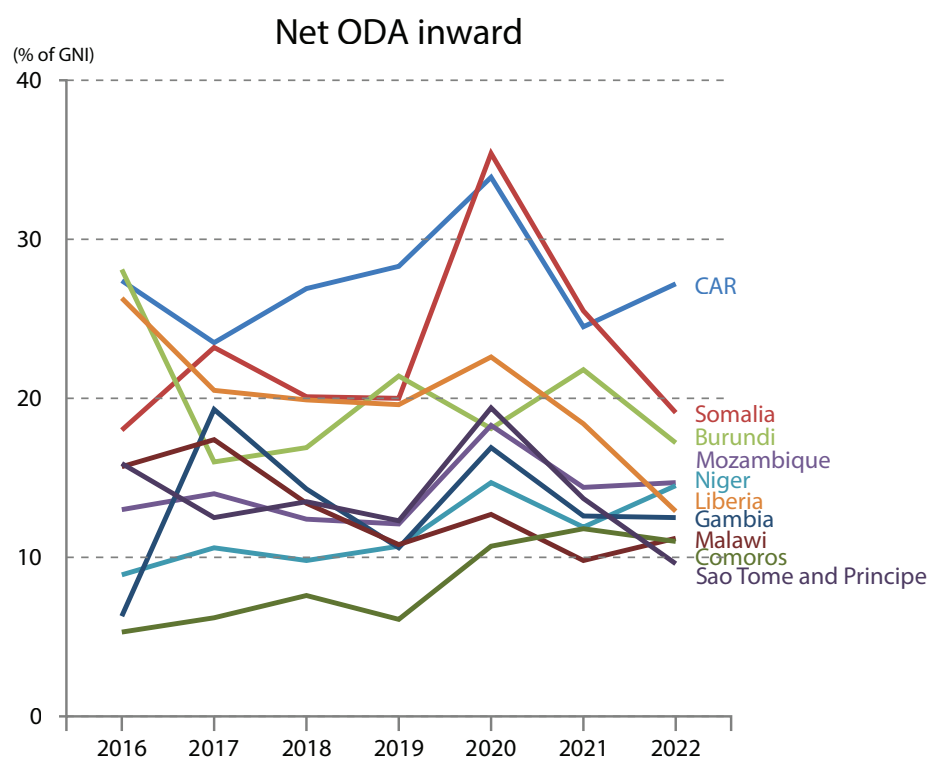
