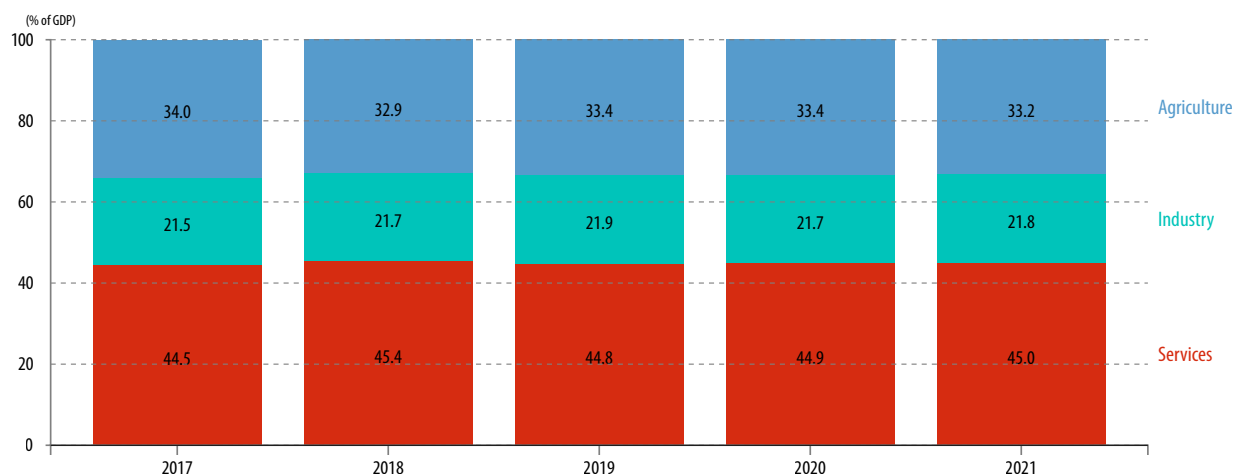

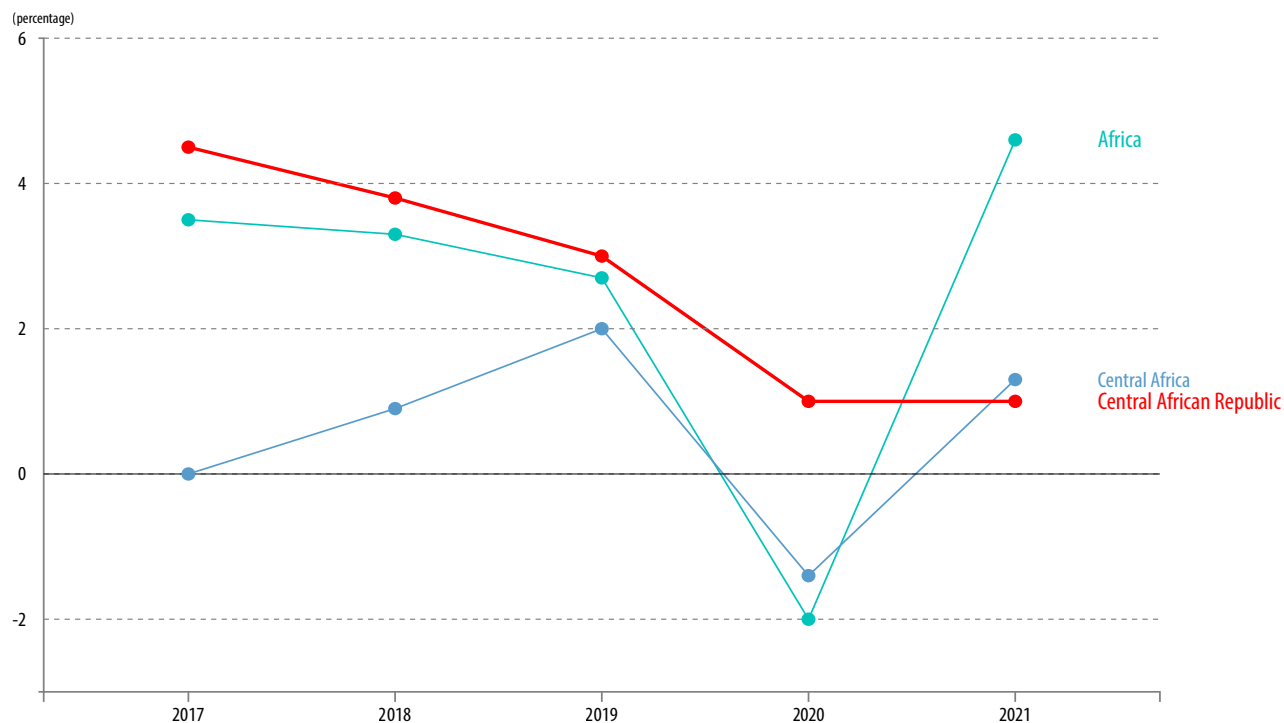


Contribution to GDP by sectors (%)

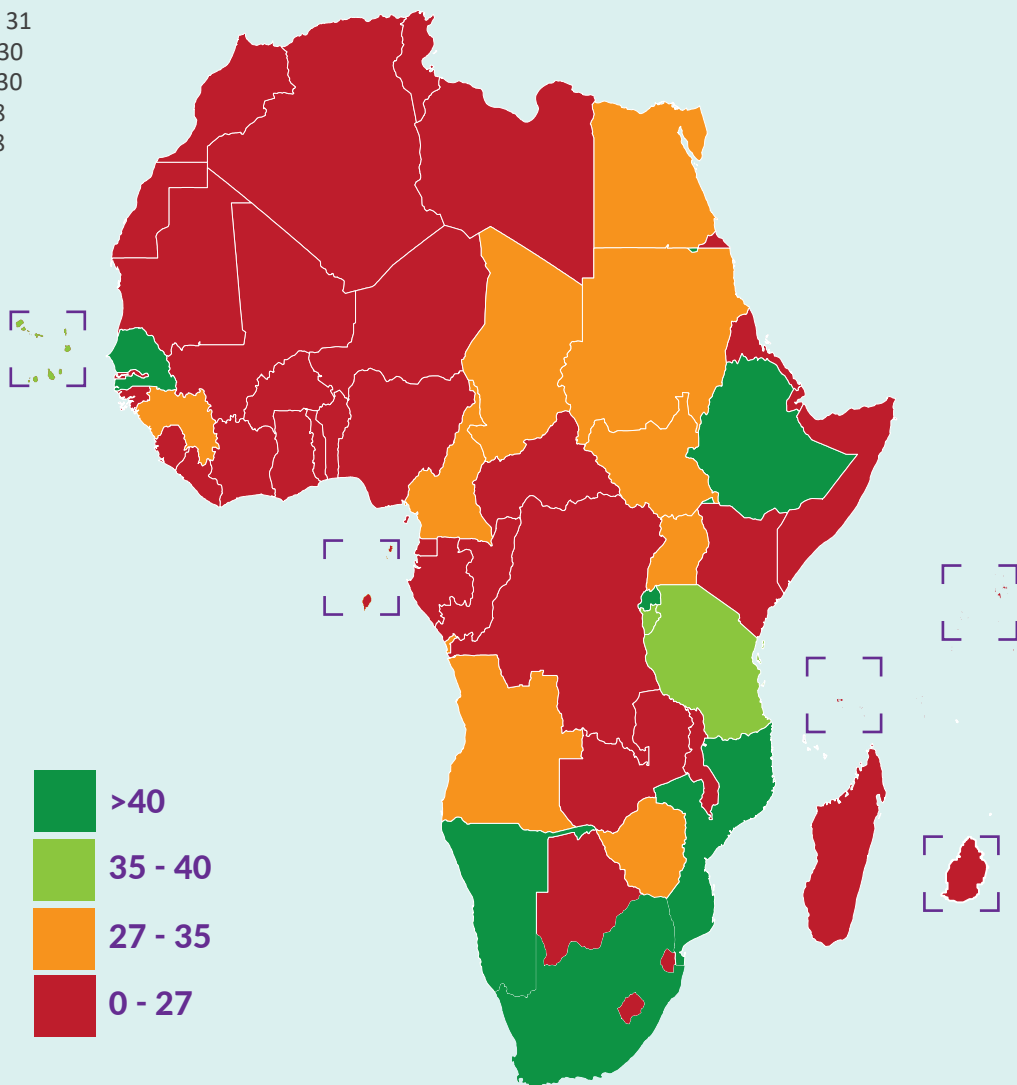
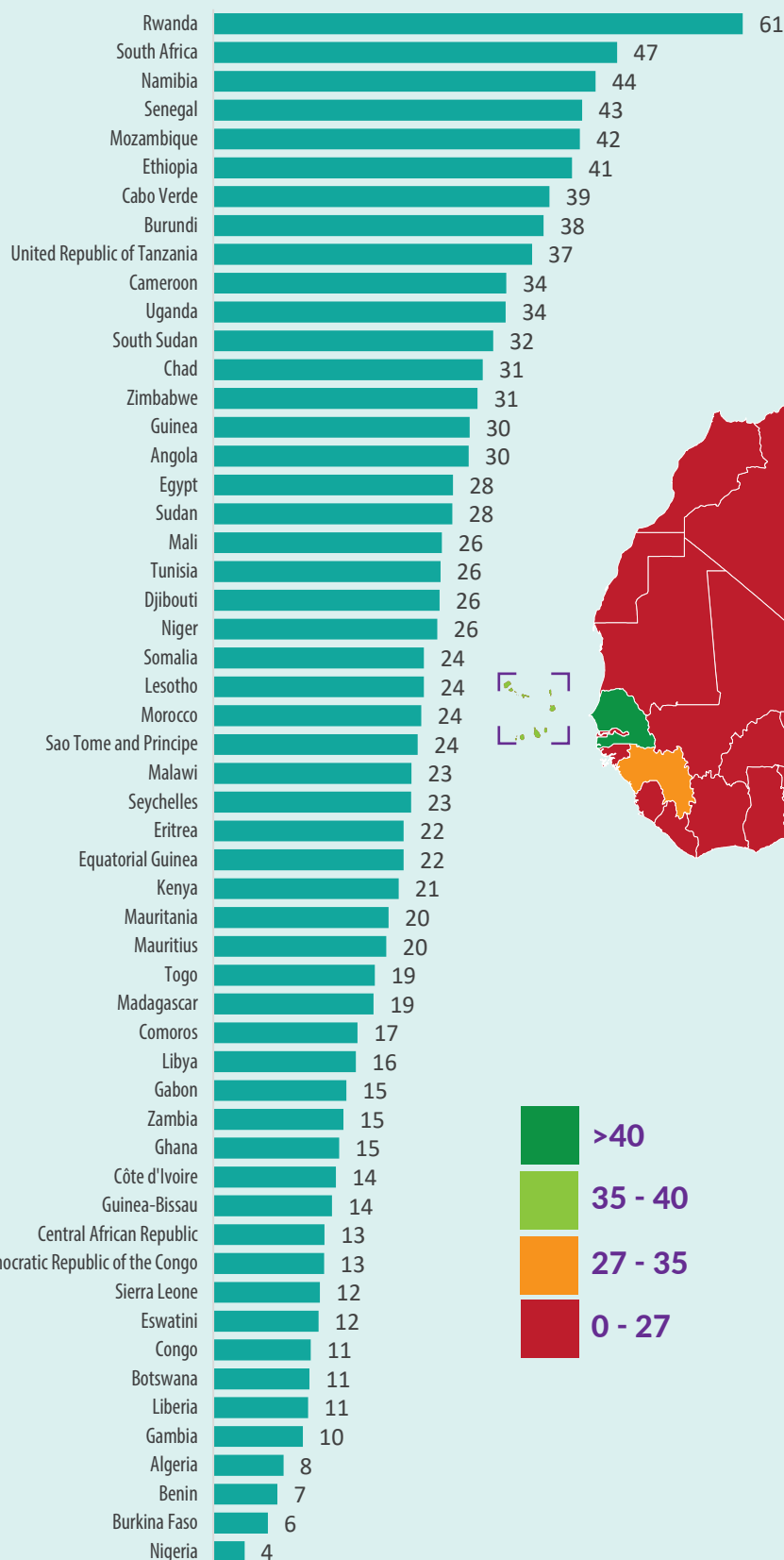

Proportion of seats held by women in national parliaments

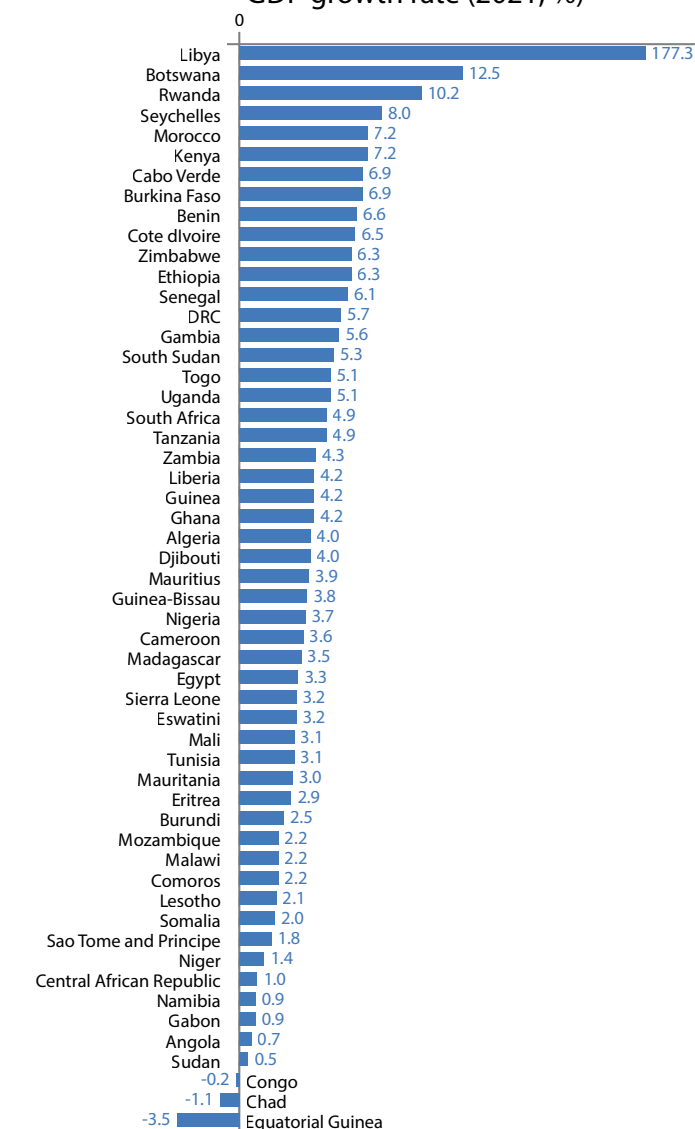
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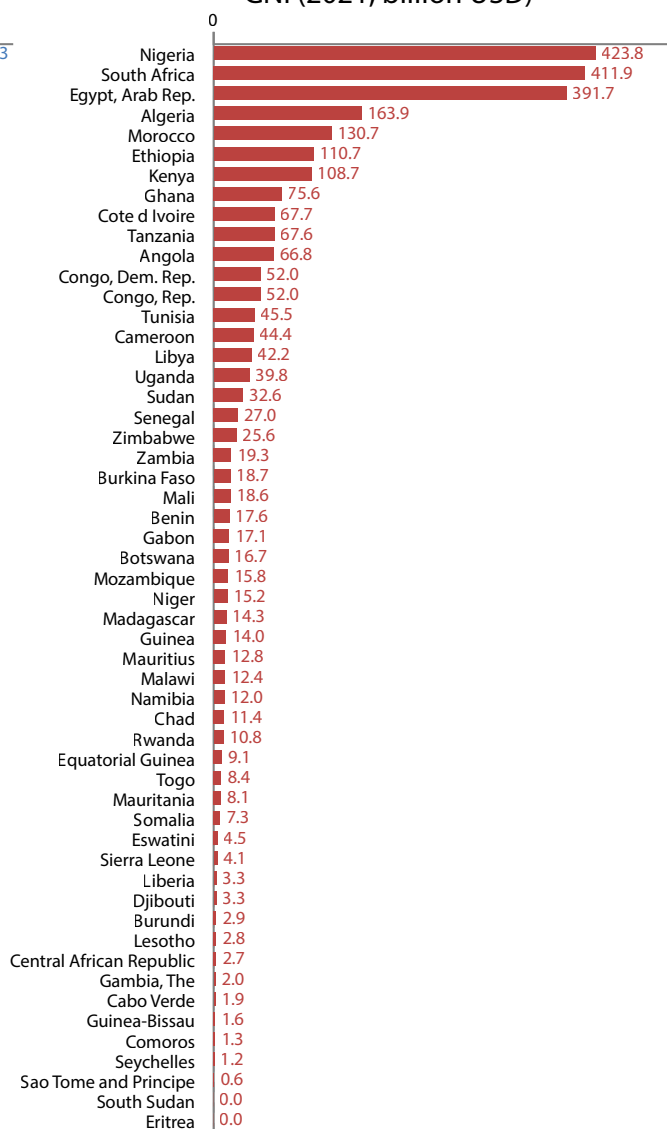

GNI (2021, billion USD)



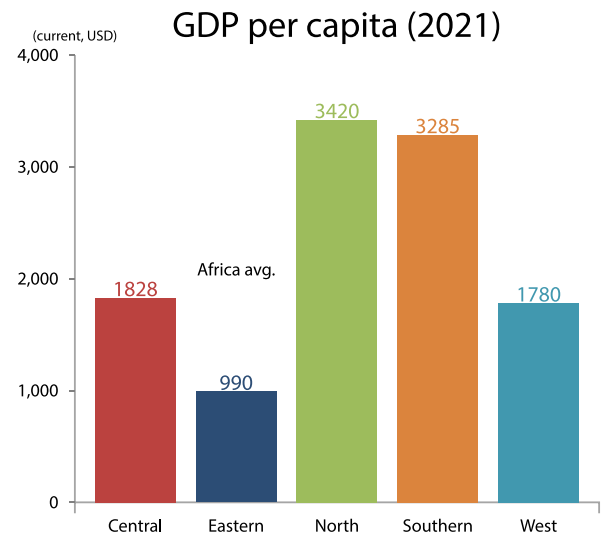
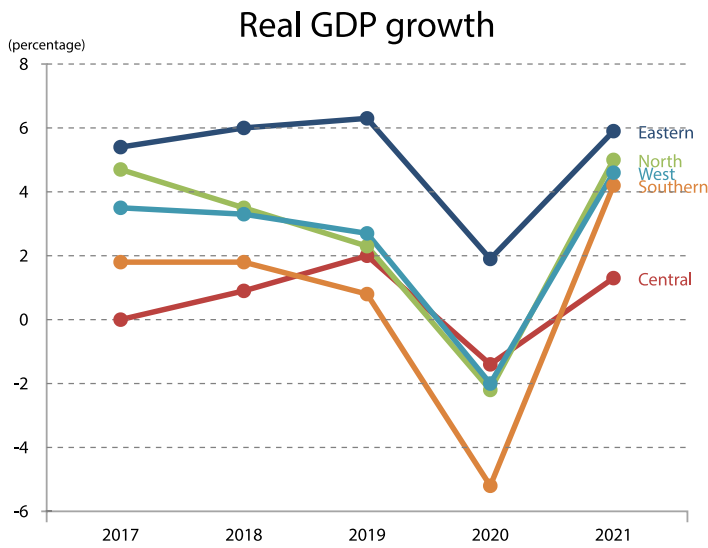

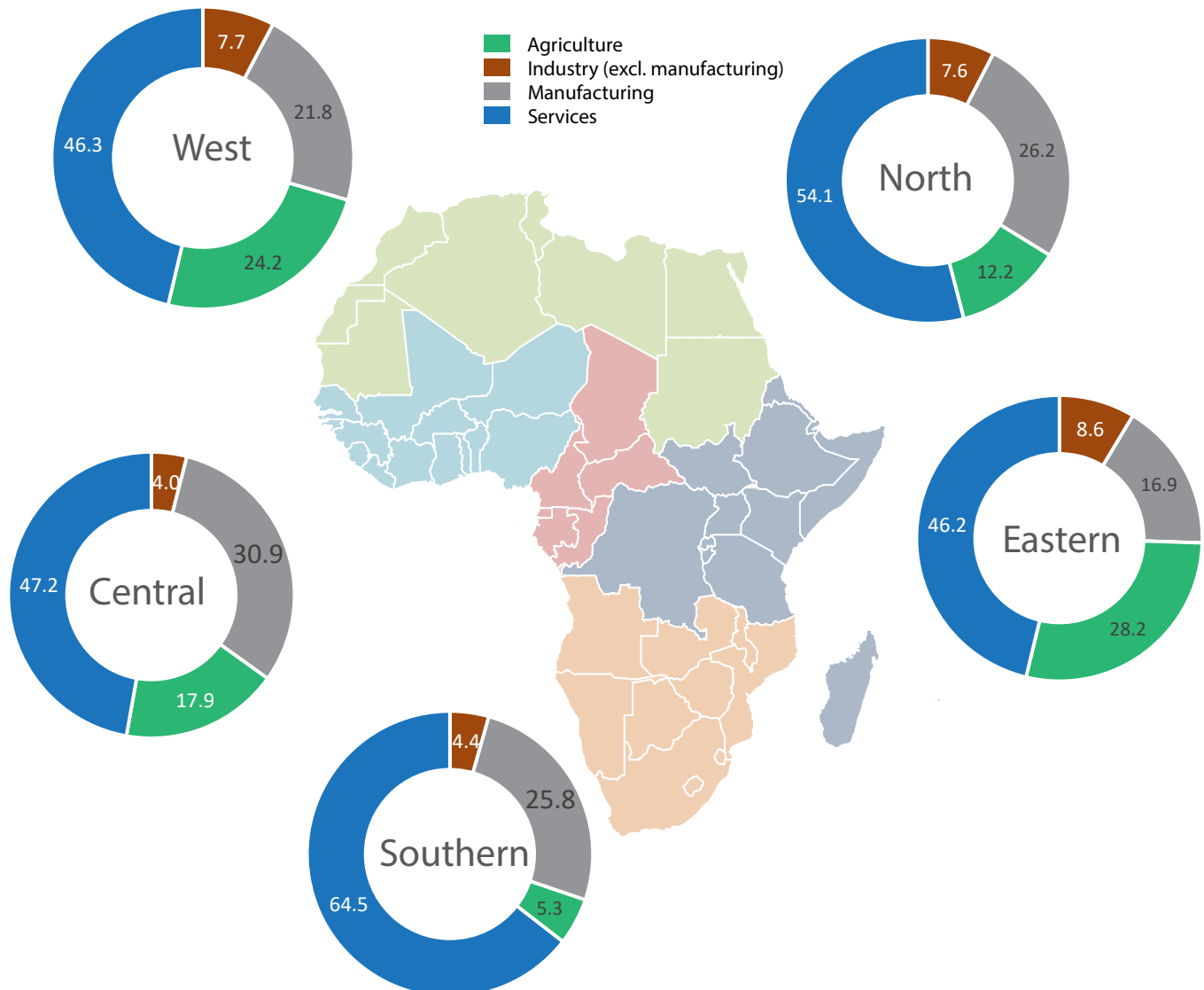

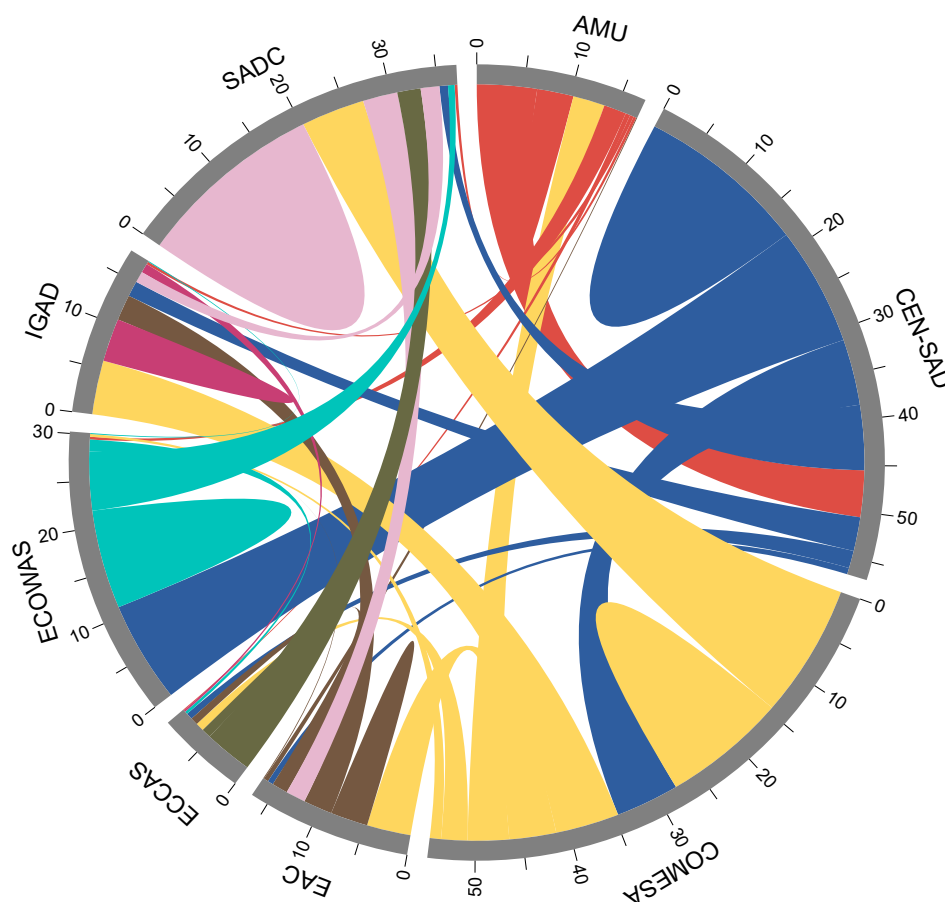

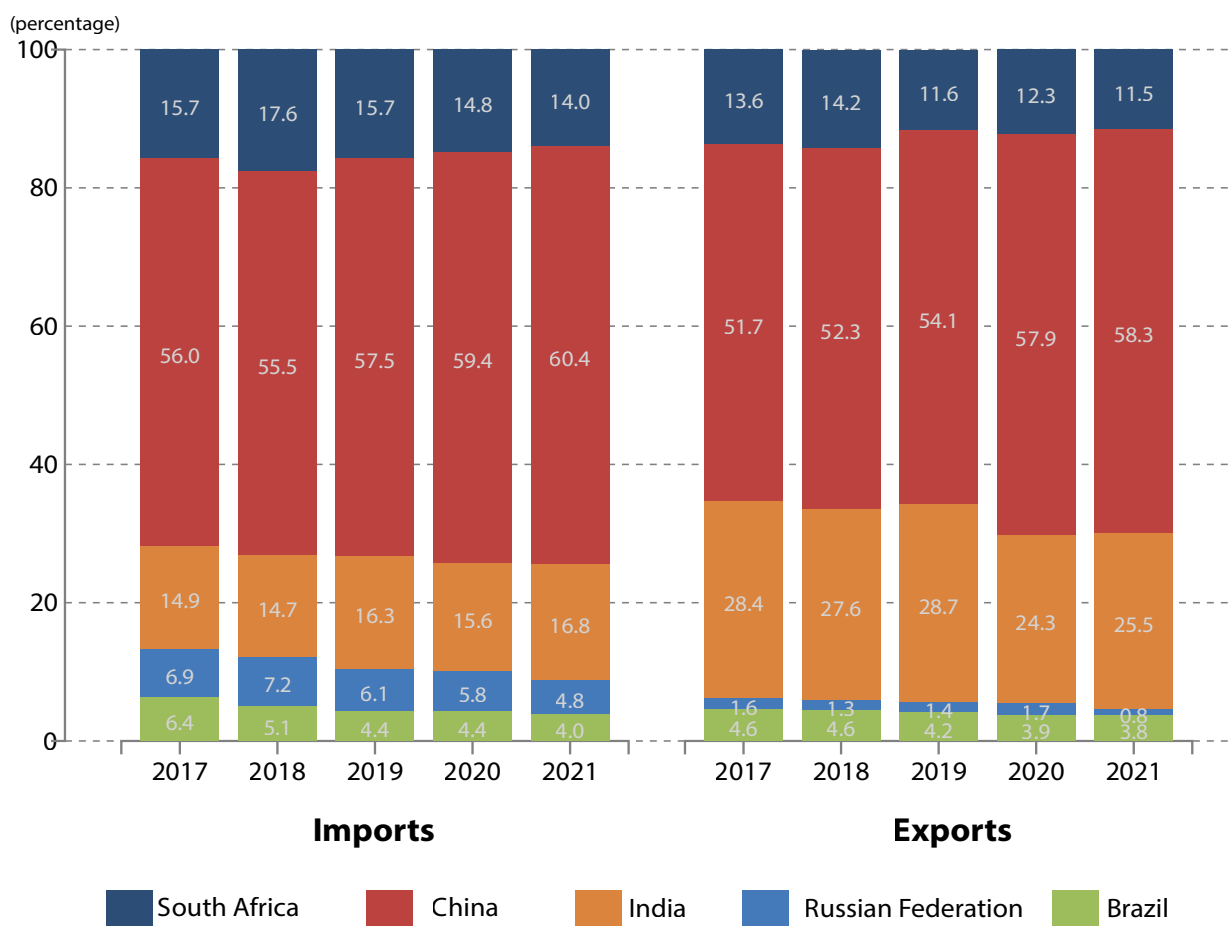

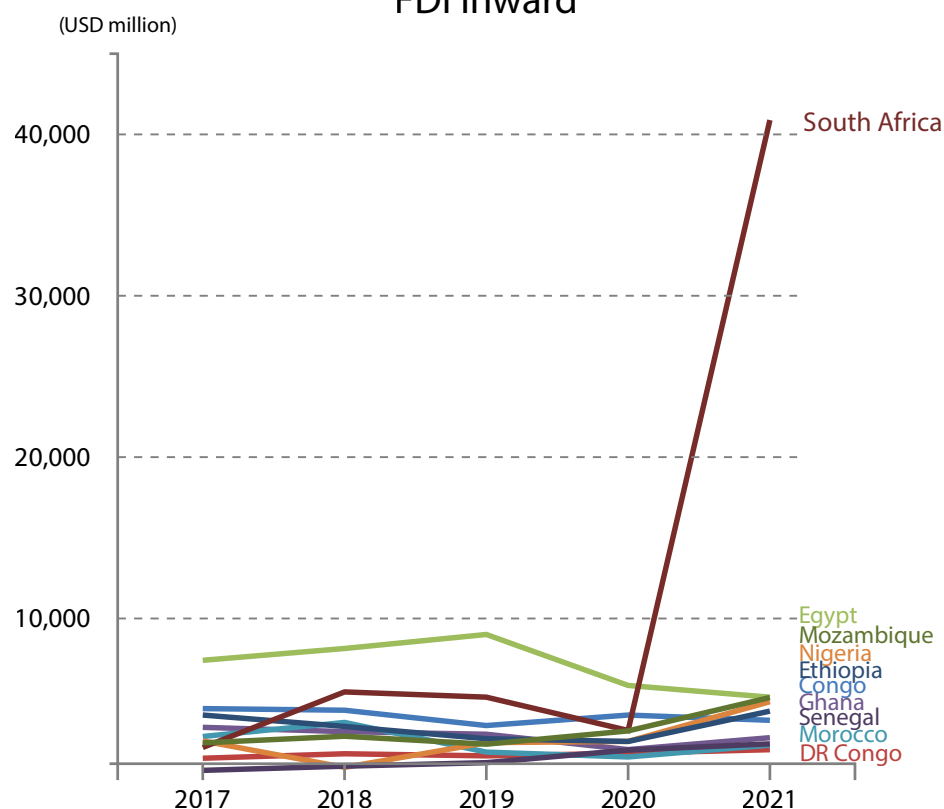

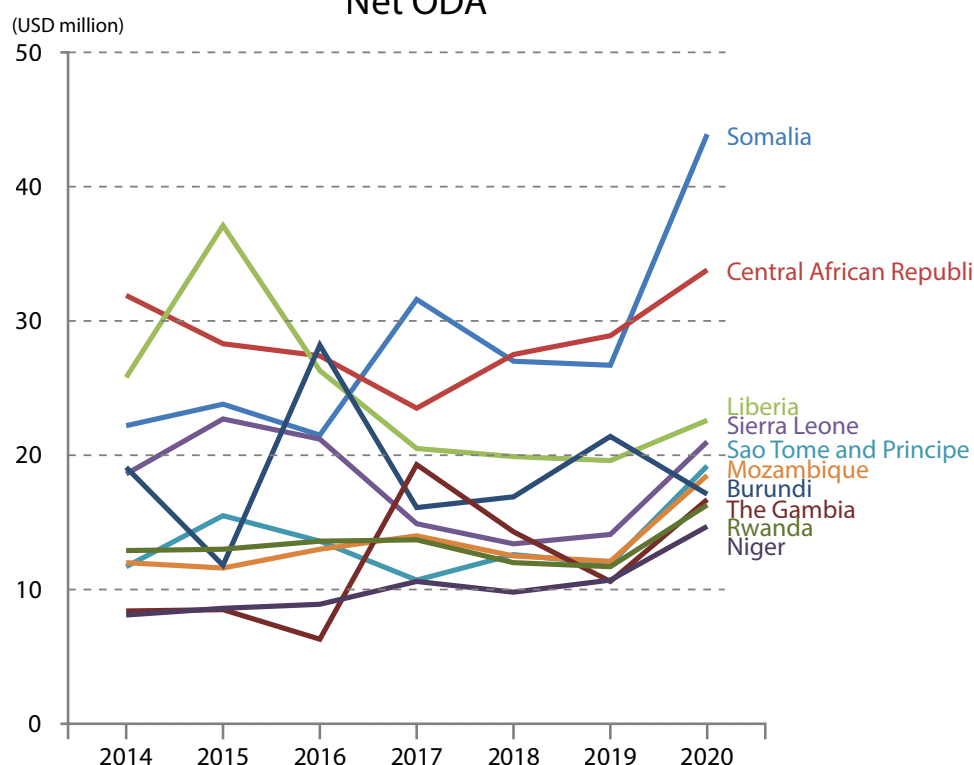
FDI inward
