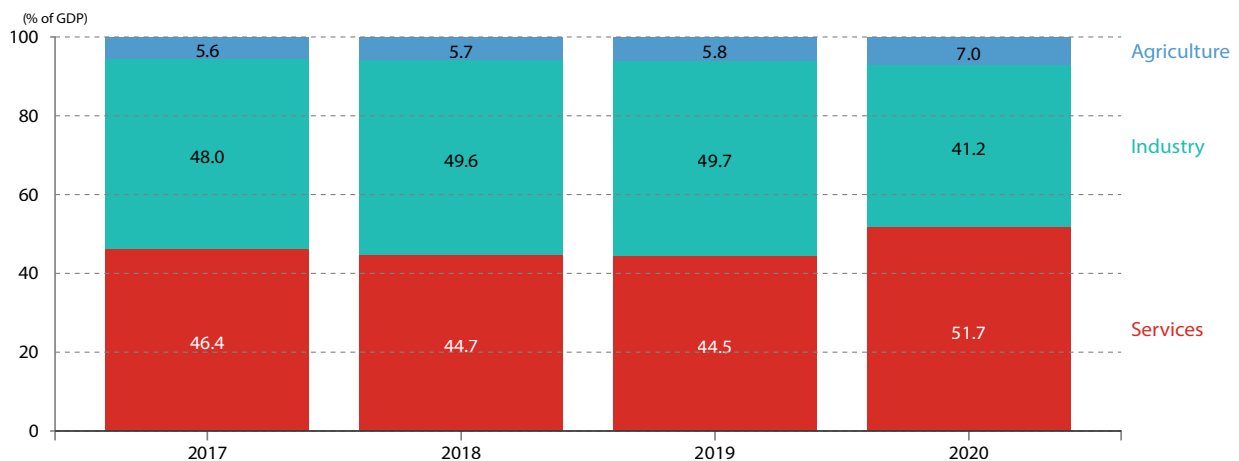

Export/Import and GDP growth rate

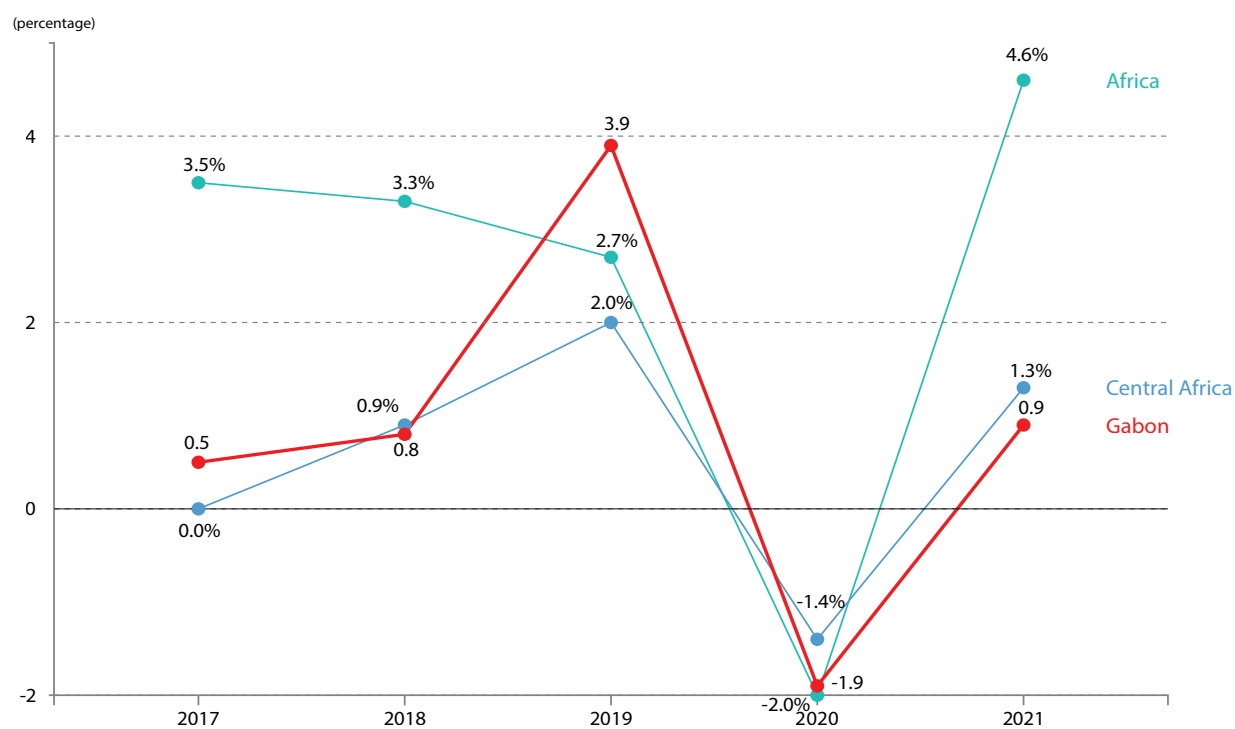


Contribution to GDP by sectors (%)

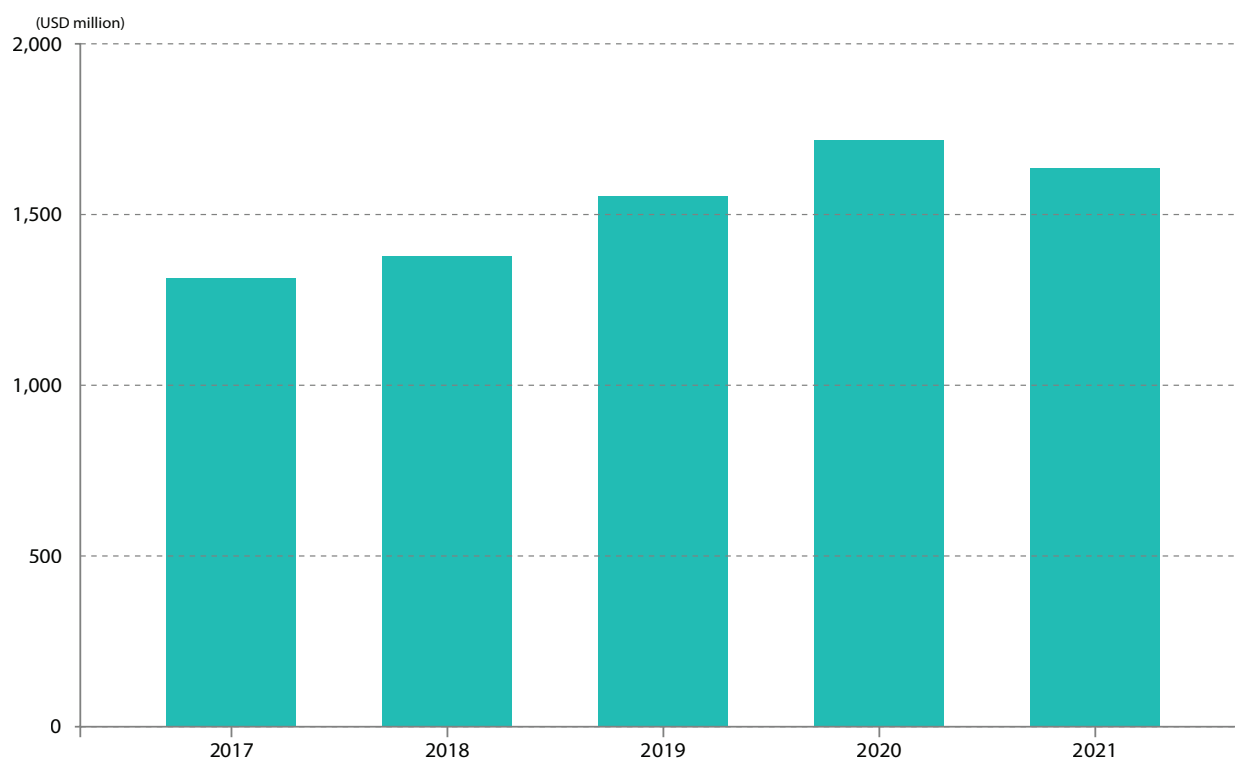

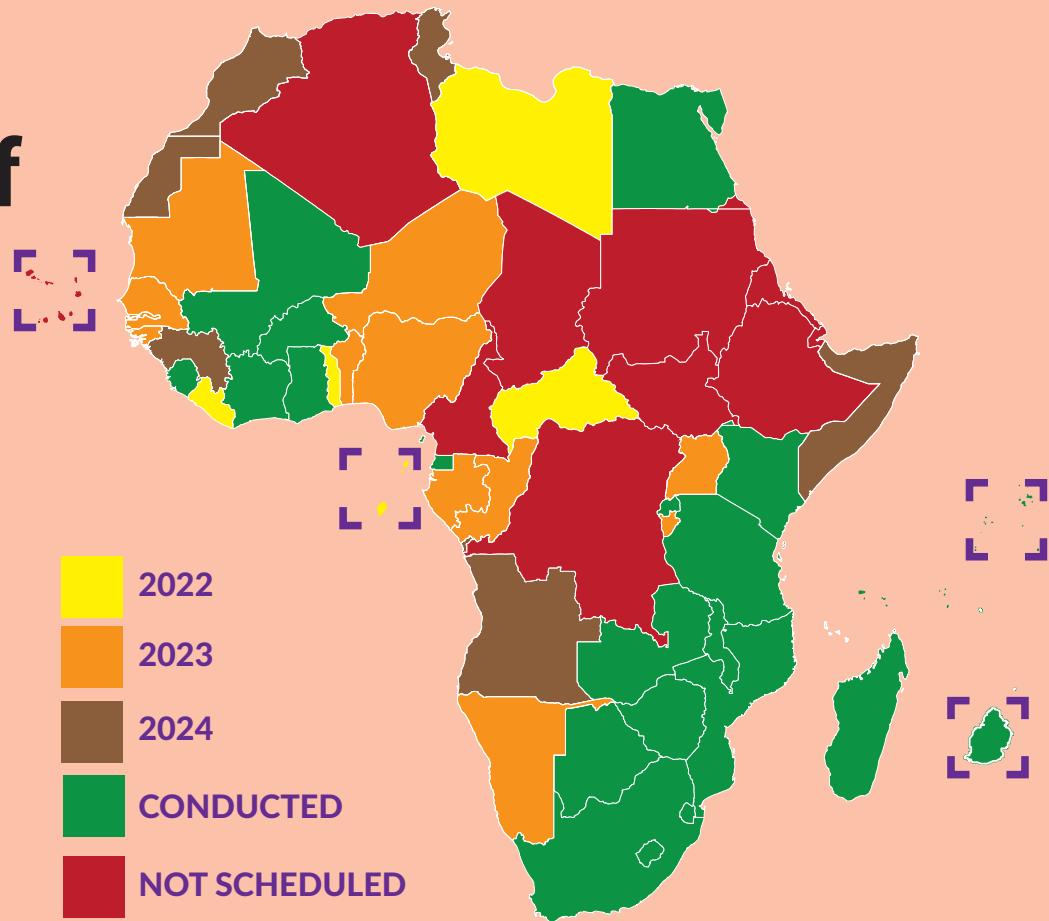

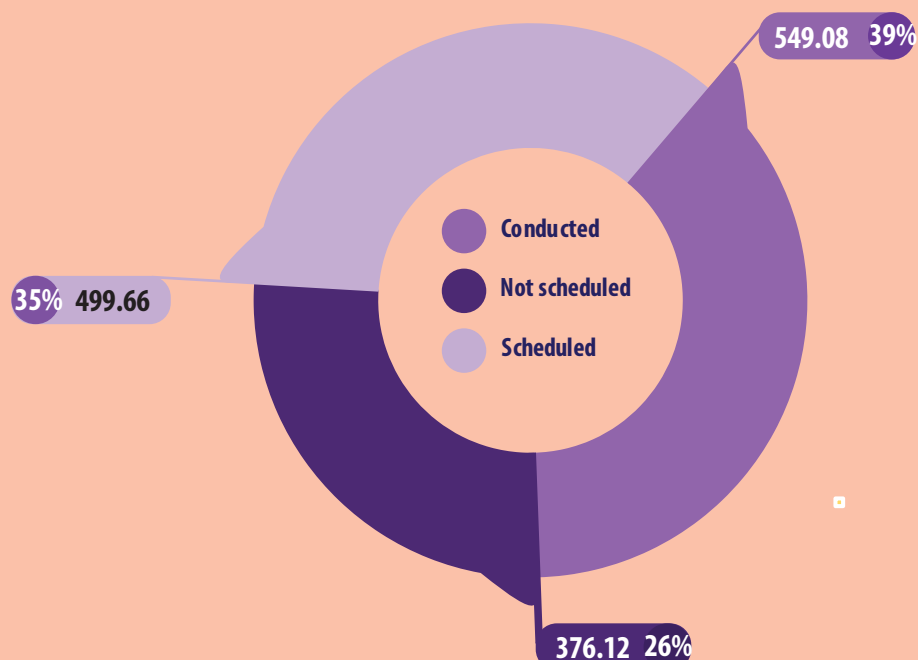

Status of the 2020 Census Round in Africa (2022 population estimate in millions)

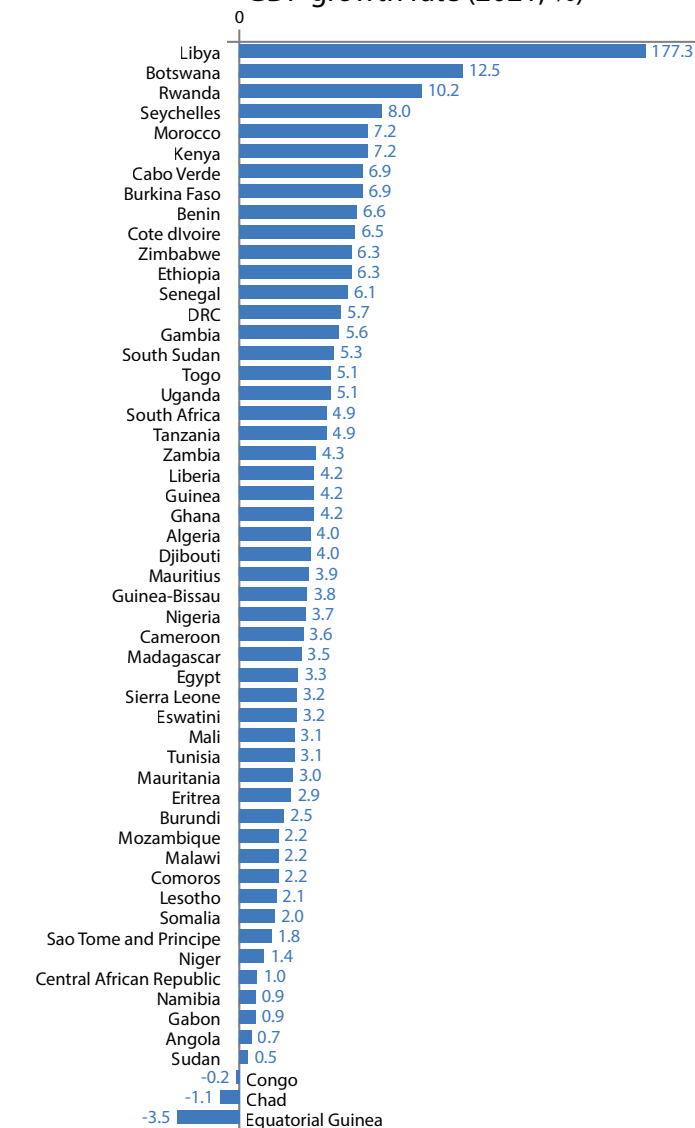

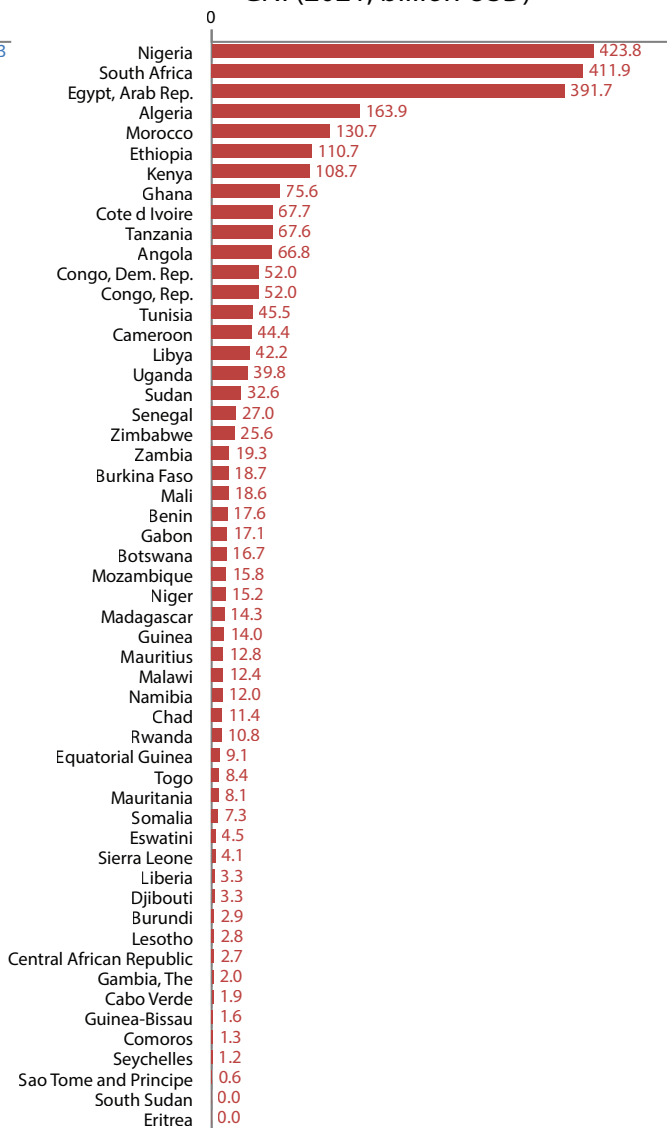

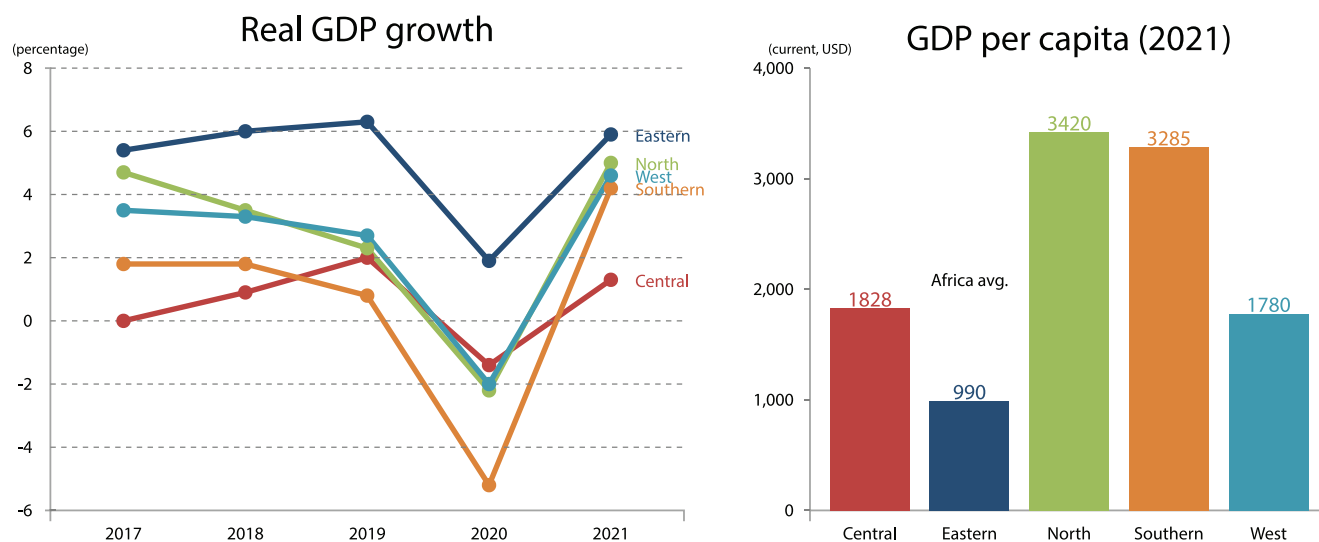

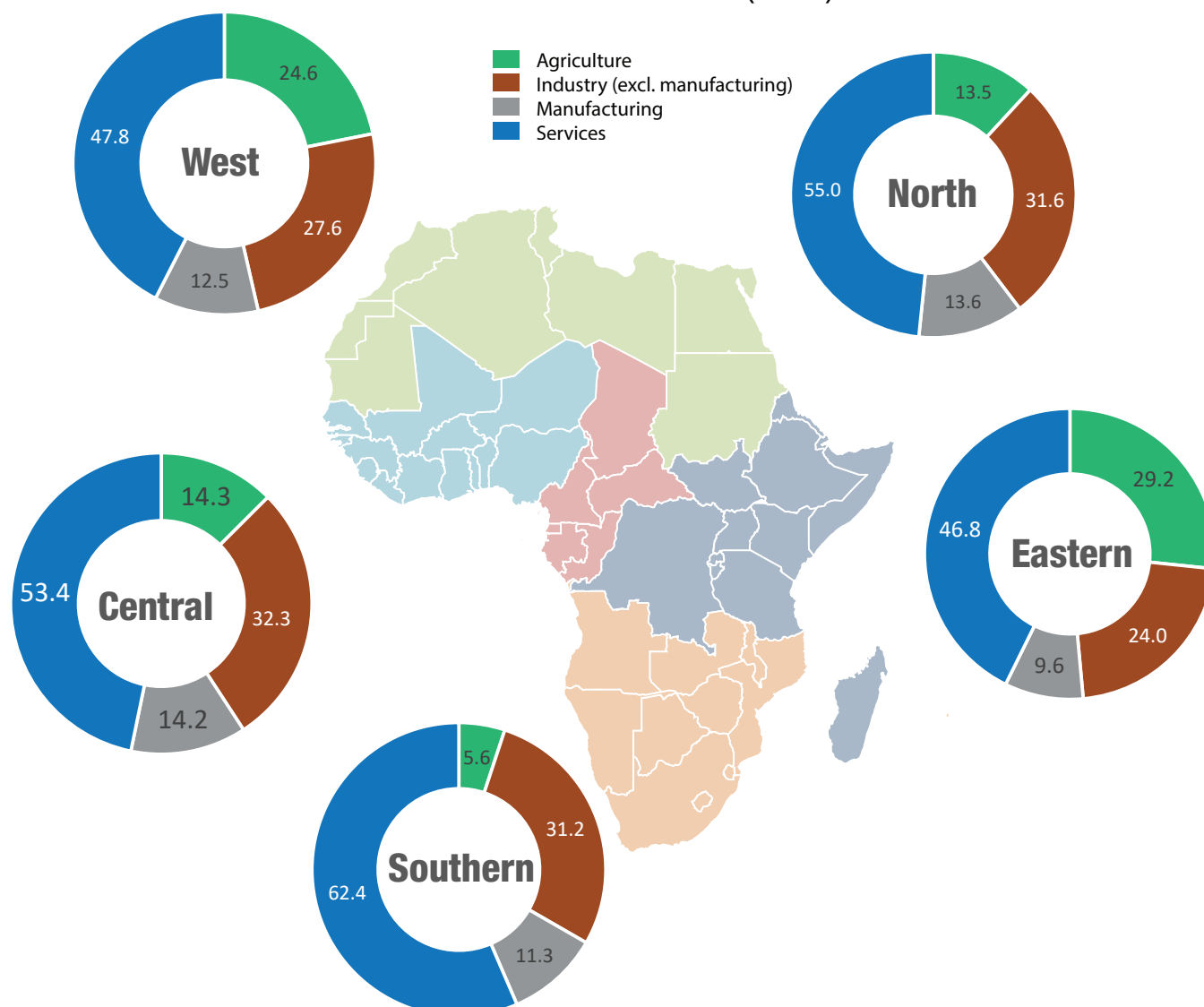

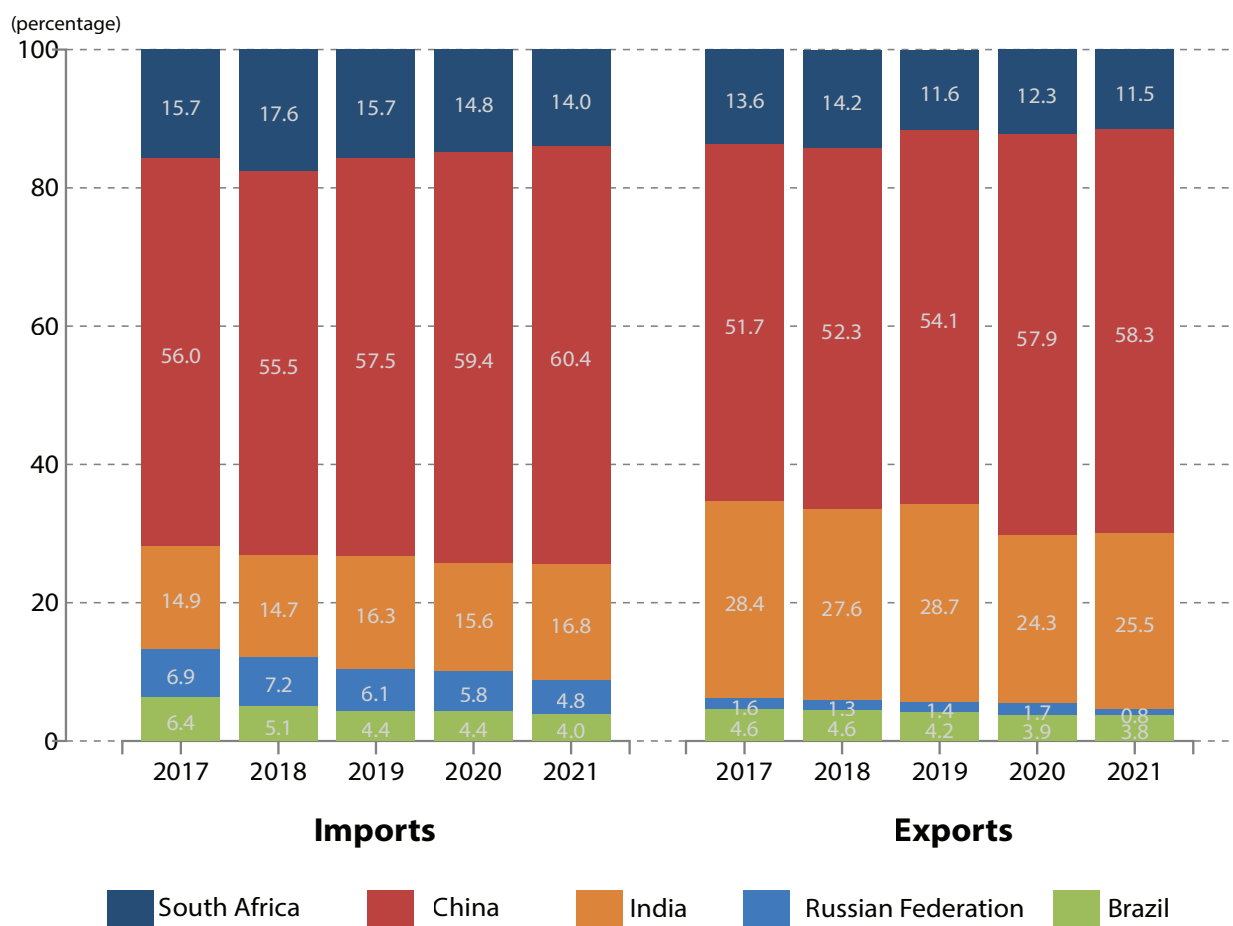

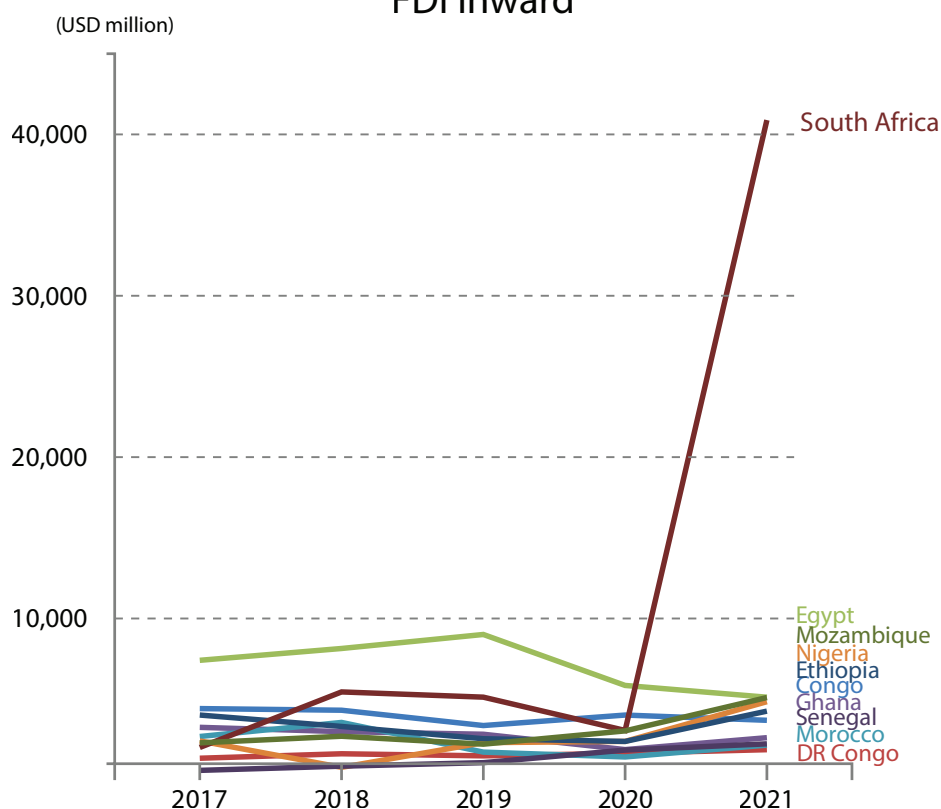

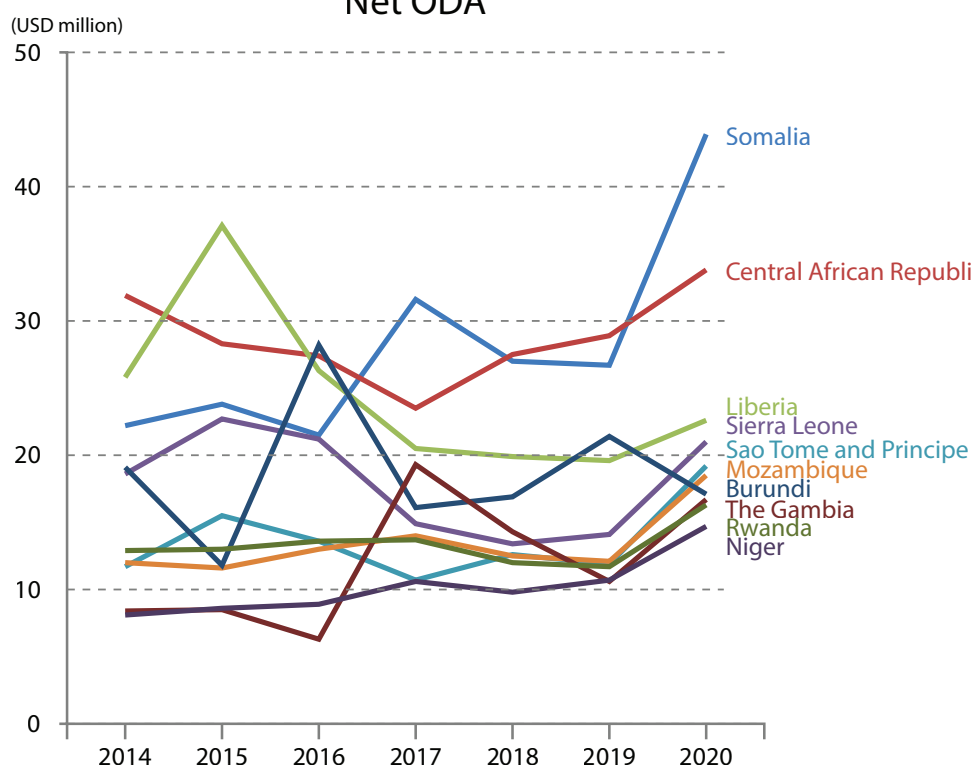
