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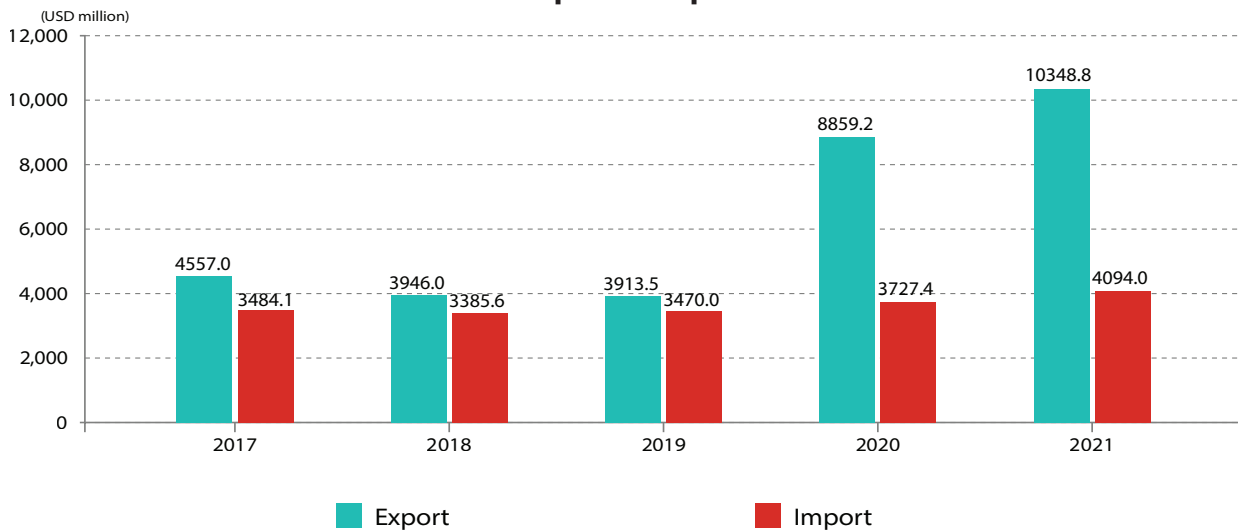

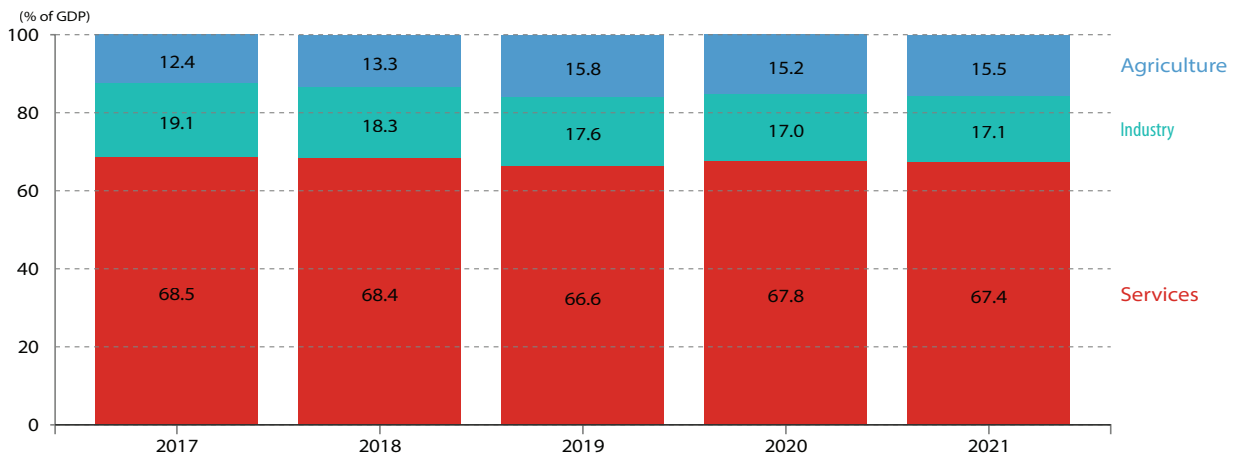

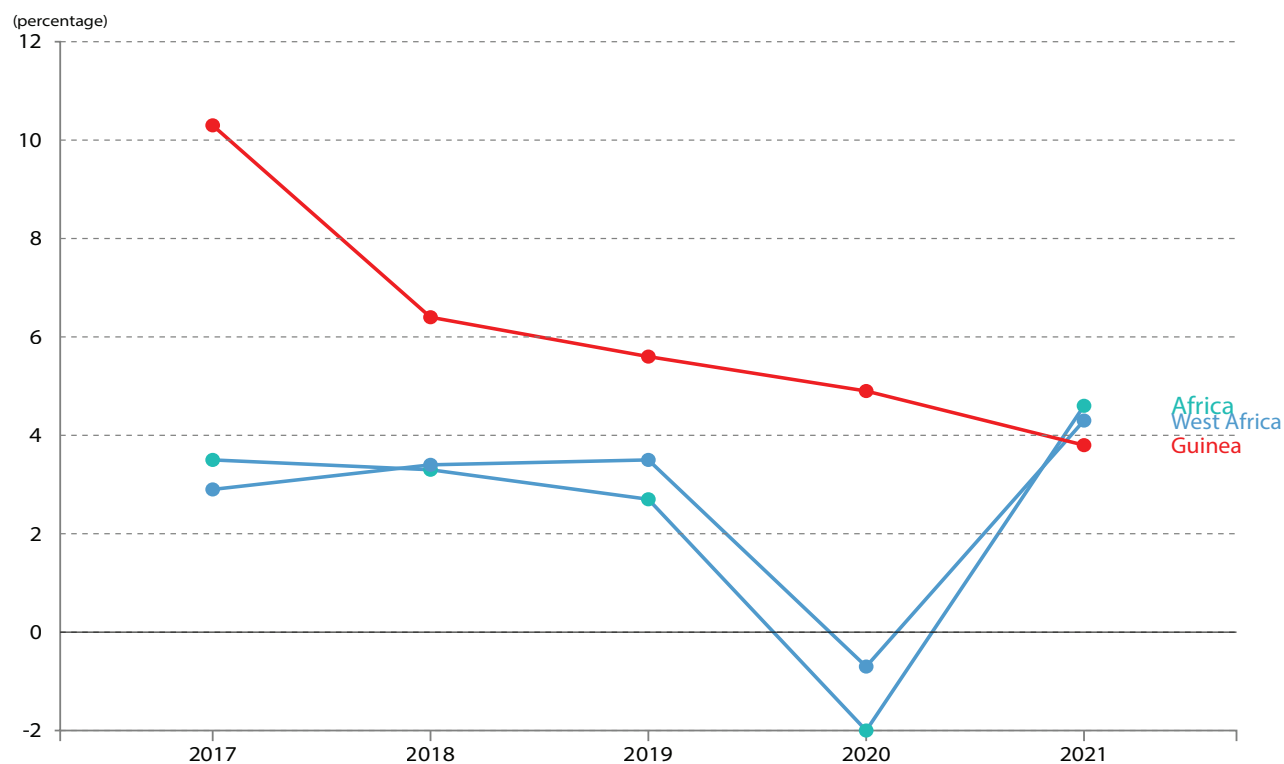


Contribution to GDP by sectors (%)

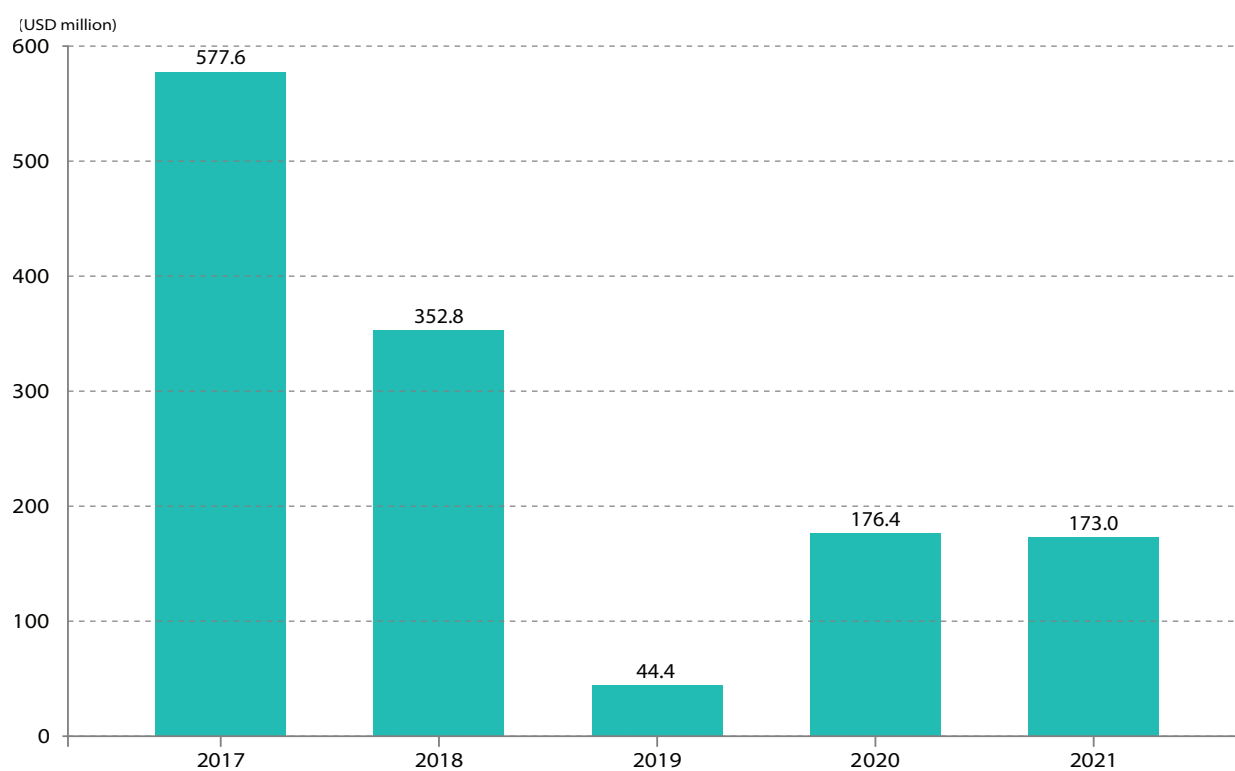

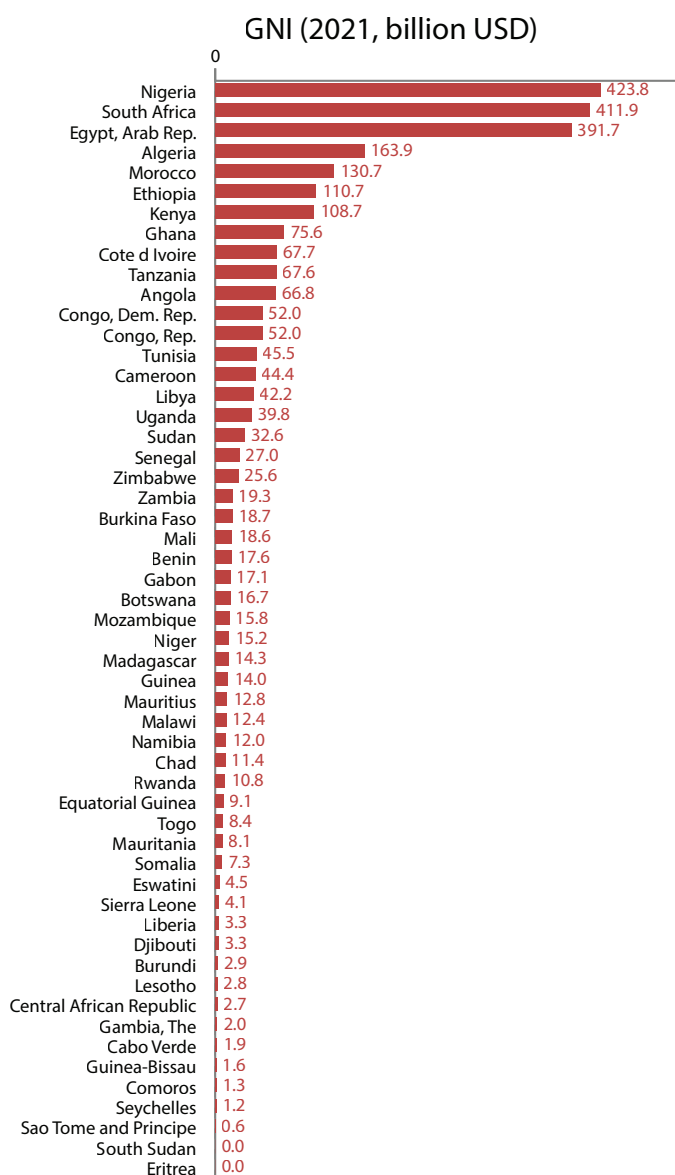
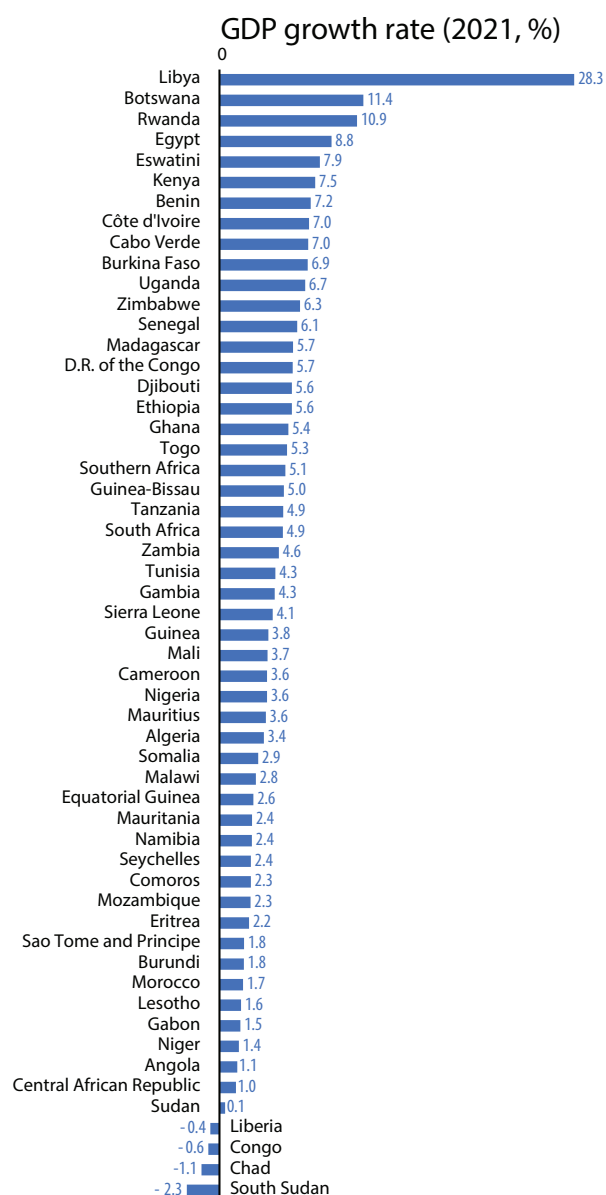


Dollar value of all resources made available to strengthen statistical capacity in developing countries

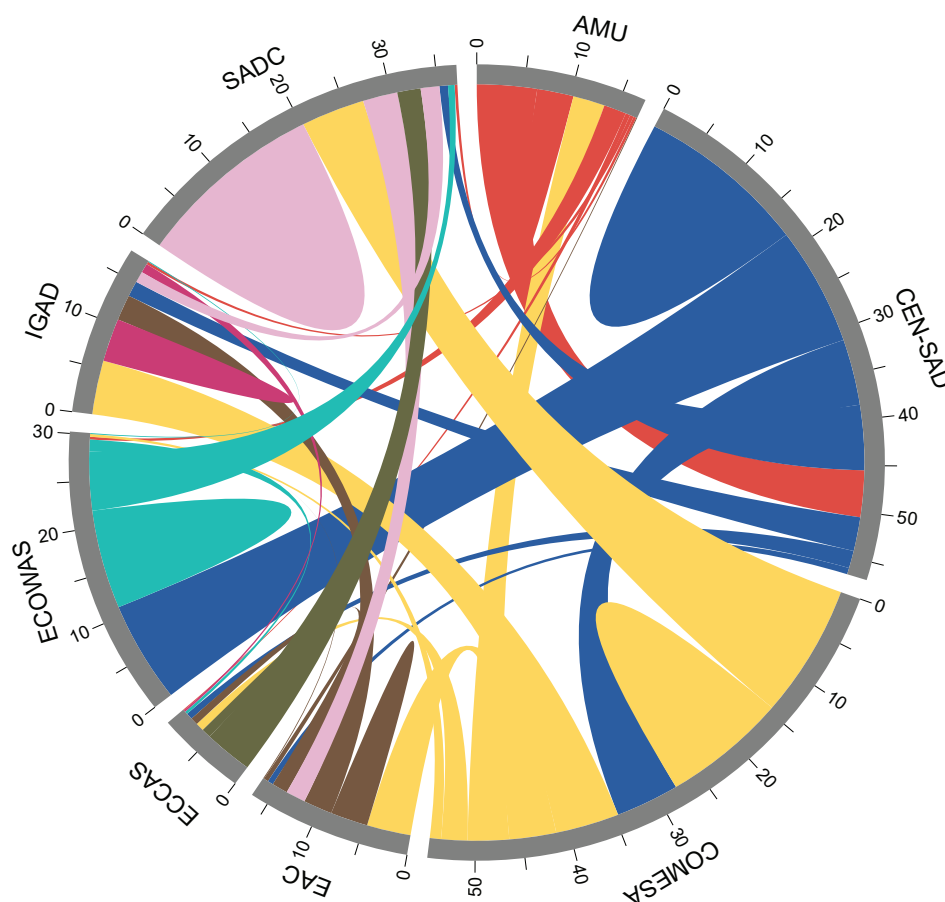

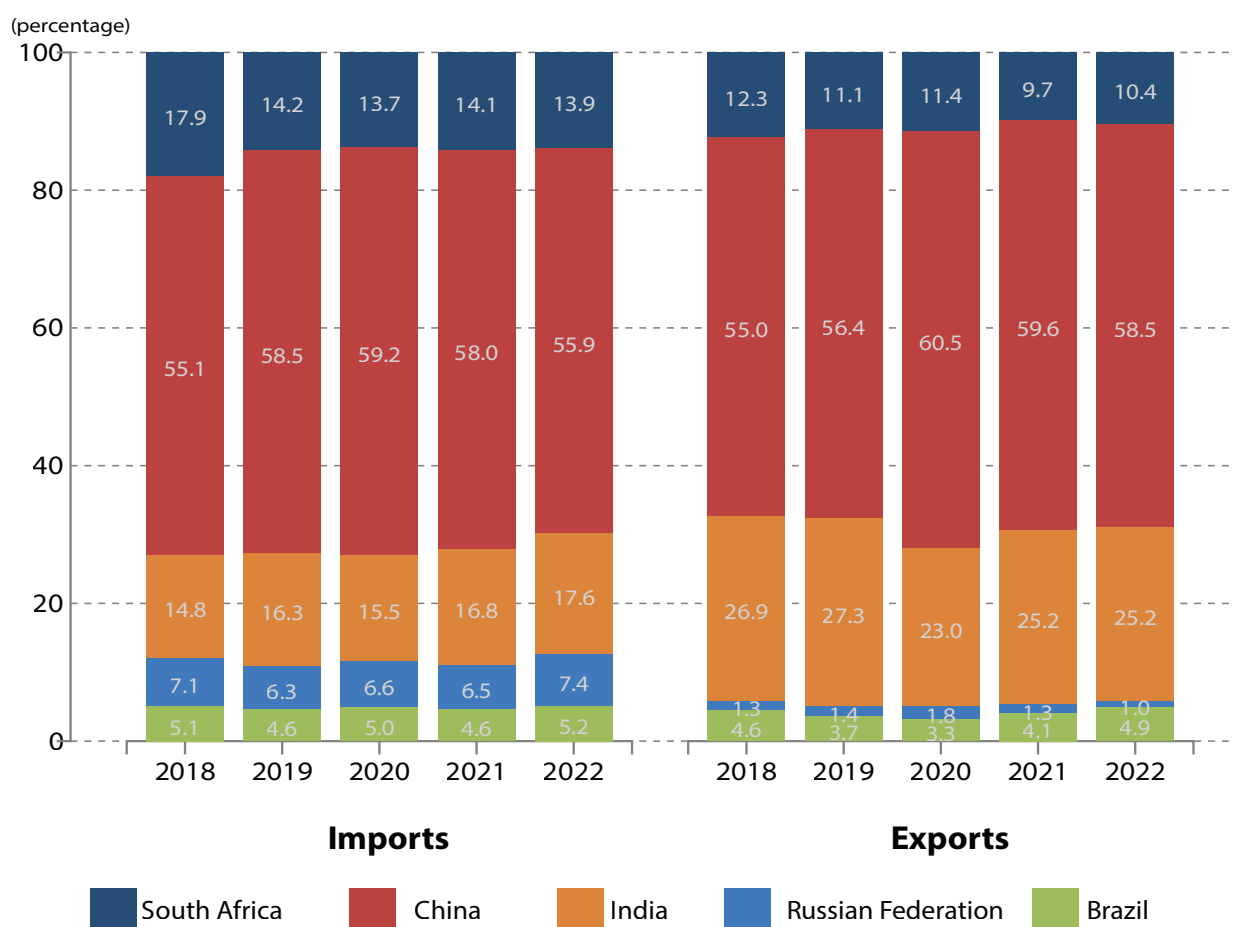

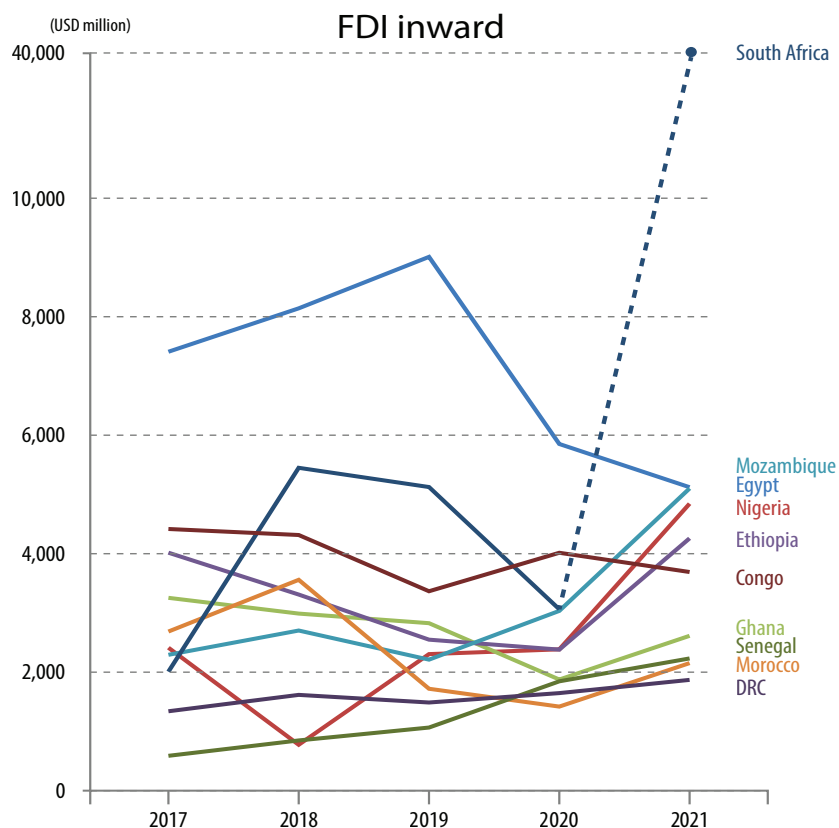

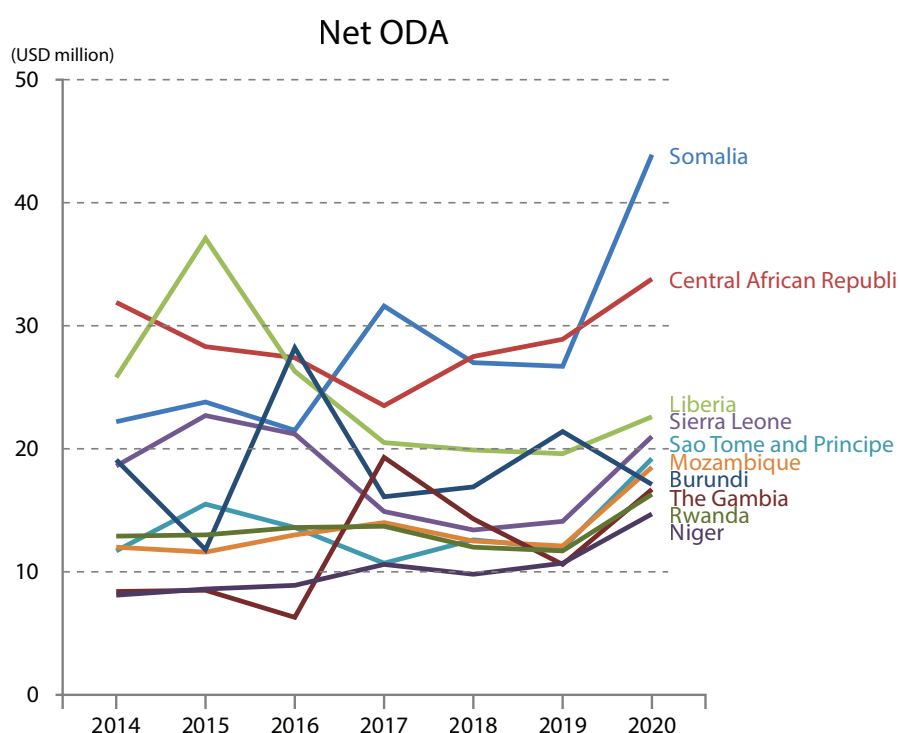
