











Structure of State of States Recurrent Revenue (2019) (NGN'bn)






Budget transparency now above regional average


- comprehensiveness of the budget proposal

Lessons Learnt – Beyond the Overall Budget

- Leadership of the Ministry of Finance and political support from the Minister is vital.
- Collaboration with Parliament, Auditor General's Office, Development Partners (UNICEF, IMF, WB, GiZ) and Civil Society Organisations (NANGO) critical to sustain and drive the reform process.
- Multi-stakeholder dialogue (government and civil society) to review/discuss the OBS results
- Linking budget transparency & social service delivery is key.

The context

Point 1: Constitutional provision for public participation in all governance aspects at National and county level

Point 2: National Open Budget Index stagnated between 45-50 points in the last 10 years (2021 at 50 points)...Participation at 31 points

Point 3: County government budget transparency at 35 points in availability and comprehensiveness...participation at 6 points

Actions

Point 1: Creation of mechanisms for public engagement beyond the capital city sessions

- Physical and email submissions call for all
- Expanded participation to Budget Review and Outlook Paper

Point 2: Increasing documentation of public input in key budget stages especially policy statement and estimates

Point 3: Limited feedback on decision markers/ justifications for the different stages – What does the input do?

Impacts

Point 1: Greater accessibility of budget documents on treasury website

Point 2: Greater trust in government by increased engagement

Next steps

Point 1: Need to diversify channels of public participation especially use of technology for national consultations

Point 2: Provide feedback on use of public input in budget decisions

Point 3: Pilot mechanism on engagement with state department for Q1 2022/23 budget implementation report
