1. July-August

Call for applications through the official website of the program



2. August-September

An intensive 3-days training bootcamp & pitching competition took place in Tunisia, Senegal, Ethiopia & Tanzania.



4. January 2023

Exploration days and final pitching ceremony in Ethiopia at the UNECA Conference Center

Winning prize: 7k usd



3. October-December

A three months online incubation program for the best 8 startups

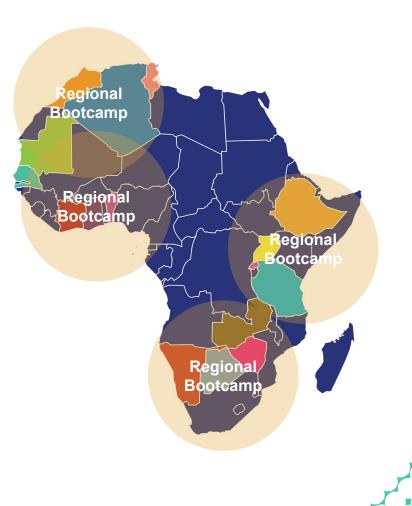

TAW 2.0: What is new?

- 16 countries (12 new countries targeted)
- 4 physical regional bootcamps gathering 80 Startups
 - 4 incubation programs going simultaneously
 - Final prize of 50k usd
 - Incubation duration: 4 months













1 Online Bootcamps in 16 countries

After selecting 20 projects per country, a series of online bootcamps will be organized to choose the best 5 startups from each country

2. Regional bootcamps

An intensive 5-7 days regional bootcamp to be held physically in 4 regional locations: North, West, East & South of Africa 20 startups per regional 60 startups overall

3. Incubation programs

4 simultaneous incubation programs for a total of 24 startups

(6 startups per incubation program)

4. Demo day

Exploration days and final pitching ceremony in Addis Ababa or Kigali for the best two startups per incubation program (8 startups in total)

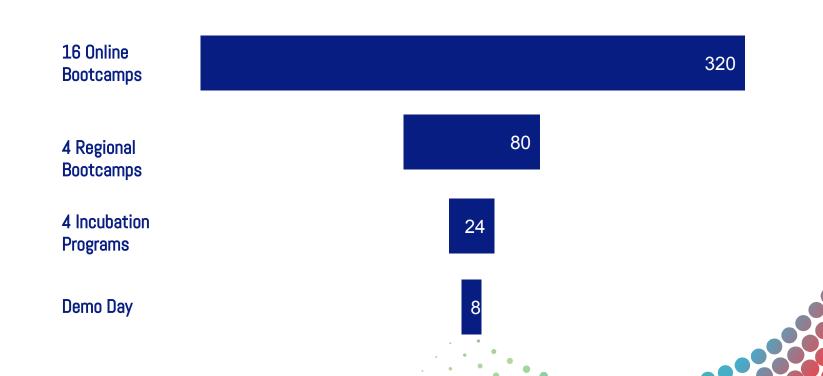

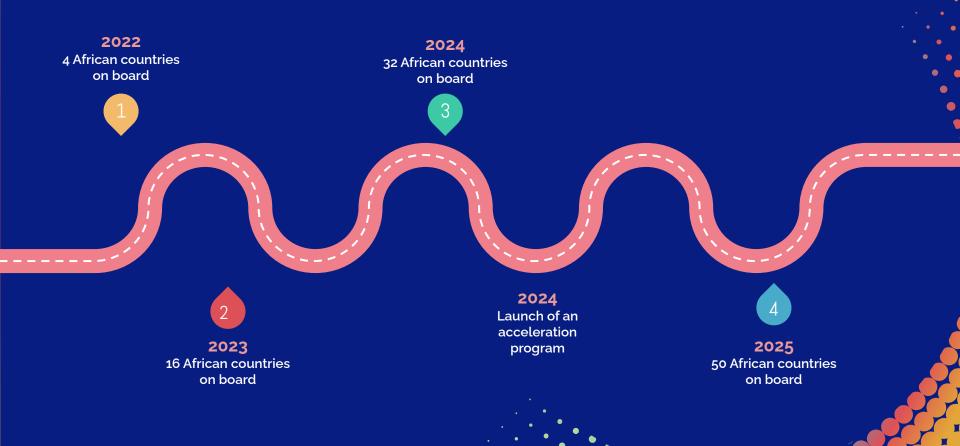
