

Basics of the 2022 HLPF

- 2022 HLPF: 5 to 7 July and 11 to 15 July
 - VNR presentations from <u>12 to 15 July</u>
- **Theme:** "Building back better from the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) while advancing the full implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development"
- SDGs under review this year:*
 - SDG 4 (quality education)
 - SDG 5 (gender equality)
 - SDG 14 (life below water)
 - **SDG 15** (life on land)
 - **SDG 17** (partnerships for the Goals)
 - *VNR reports should cover ALL 17 SDGs @
- Format: in-person/hybrid, to be confirmed in May










Africa's VNRs: 21 countries in 2022

Fourth time - 1




