



CURRENT PROVISIONS FOR GREEN ECONOMY DEVELOPMENT IN CENTRAL AFRICA

The transition towards a green economy requires firm political will by the States.

At sub-regional level, a number of existing provisions augur bright prospects for the green economy: the Yaoundé Declaration (1999) and the Treaty on Conservation and Management of Central African Forest Ecosystems of 5 February 2005.

Central African countries are expected to make a special effort to design land tenure policies.
